Volleyball Update-

Volleyball's season ended at the district tourney in McCall. The varsity team had its ups and downs. Coach Nash did a good job coaching the girls up and kept high expectations throughout the season. The SRV was a very difficult league this season. Three teams from our conference qualified for the state tournament with Fruitland finishing 2nd at state and Weiser finishing 3rd.
