

Executive Summary

Full Year Discipline Trend

Major Takeaways:

We are down 280 discipline referrals (9,007) this year compared to 2017-2018 (9,287). This data includes bus referrals.

We are slightly up 59 referrals (8,277) compared to 2017-2018 (8,218). This data does not include bus referrals.

Our major infractions which include fights, drugs, and weapons decreased by 31 referrals. In 2017-2018, we were at 191 compared to 160 in 2018-2019.

Overall, we realize there is always room for improvement, but to know where we are going.....it's good to look and see where we have been. In 2014-2015, we had 10,351 discipline referrals. This year we had 9,007 which is a decrease of 1,344 referrals.

Other information:

ORC – Overnight Required Conferences – These are utilized when a teacher or administrator makes multiple attempts to communicate with our parents. Some examples would be behavior in the classroom or on a bus. We also utilize ORC's to assist with proofs of residency and vaccination requirements.
