Current Work

- The middle school is changing to iReady for our math interim assessment for the 2024-25 school year
 - In order for us to get baseline data for our students and to help staff plan for next year, we will be doing a 4th interim assessment with our 6th and 7th graders this month
 - 8th grade students that will be going into Pre-Algebra in 9th grade next year will also be taking this assessment
