ATTENDANCE:

The district will continue to work towards creating a district wide approach to increase our attendance rates. Data, such as the one below, is used to assist.

Attendance Committee:

The attendance subcommittee has reviewed districts in state and out of state attendance policies. They will present recommendations for any possible changes to current policies. This is not intended to be a negative report for the parents but a way to identify how better to support students and families.

Presently, the only choices in powerschool are Absent, Excused or Absent, Unexcused. A power school report that lists each student with the days absent, days present, and attendance percentage can reviewed by district and school and consequently, presented to parents. There is an opportunity to allow for categories such as: appointments; fever; out of town; etc. The committee will work with the secretaries and power school in creating more attendance categories.

We have had 456 student responses from the Absenteeism surveys. That is a great result and gives us some great feedback on Attendance.

Results of the Absenteeism surveys include:Most Common to least common reasons of absenceMinor Illness37% of respondentsAppointment30% of respondentsSpending time with Parent30% of respondentsToo Cold to walk26% of respondentsTaking Care of siblings22% of respondentsSchool sports activities22% of respondents

PSA's are continually going out on KOTZ radio with ways to help students increase their attendance in school.

ENROLLMENT:

K-12's current enrollment is 1859, a increase of 26 students since June's count. $PreK - 12^{th}$ grade enrollment is 1888, a decrease of 77 students.
