This item requests approval of the Order of Election to be held on May 10, 2014.

The Election Code applies to all general, special, and primary elections held in the state of Texas.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Time for Ordering Election – Election Code Sec. 3.005 – (a) As a result of the 82nd Texas Legislative Session, an election ordered by an authority of a political subdivision shall be ordered not later than the 71st day before Election Day.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Costs associated with conducting this election have been included in our current fiscal year budget. Costs will be paid from the General Fund.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

Compliance with the Secretary of State recommended dates for ordering an election.

PROCEDURAL AND REPORTING IMPLICATIONS:

The Joint Election Contract with Denton County will be presented for Board approval at the February 25, 2014 meeting.
