






Student Achievement - Elementary & Middle Schools





District Rating Calculations






Proportional Weighting

District domain ratings are calculated using a proportionality method. This methodology only considers campus enrollment counts for grades 3–12, and is applied to each domain/area.



Divide the number of grade 3–12 students at each campus by the district total that equals the weight that each campus contributes to the district domain score.
