Subject: CCMR Student Survey

HISTORY:

A survey was developed and distributed on February 26, 2025, to gauge student interest across 11 programs of study, 12 career pathways, and one Early College High School option, totaling 13 college and career readiness opportunities. Additionally, the Health Science program was disaggregated to specifically assess student interest in its two distinct health career pathways (Patient Care Technician and EMT).

The survey included the following information for each pathway: program of study, a summary description of the career pathway, the type of certification students could earn, and a rating of interest.

Student interest was measured on a scale from 0 to 10, with 0 indicating the lowest interest and 10 the highest. A total of 543 students completed the survey. Participation in the survey included the following grade levels:

- 163 seventh-grade students
- 179 eighth-grade students
- 106 ninth-grade students
- 95 tenth-grade students

Program Results were as follows:

1. San Elizario Early College: 3,409
2. Culinary: 3,014
3. Graphic Design: 2,622
4. Cosmetology: 2,585
5. Law Enforcement: 2,502
6. Biomedical Science: 2,395
7. *Patient Care Technician (Health Science): 2,353
8. Business Management: 2,351
9. Engineering: 2,327
10. Automotive: 2,311
11. Carpentry: 2,253
12. *EMT (Health Science): 2,244

Additionally, the interest rating scale will be revised to range from 0 to 3, with 0 indicating the lowest interest and 3 the highest.
