SUBJECT:

Consideration of Approval of Course Fee Requests and/or Modification for Spring 2021

RECOMMENDATION

The District President recommends that the Board of Trustees approves the proposed lab fees, effective as of spring 2021.

RATIONALE

Diagnostic Medical Sonography: The proposed fee will cover exam gloves, sonographic printer paper, transducer supplies and exam table disinfectant.

Emergency Medical Services:

EMS Testing: These proposed fees provide a secure testing experience that can be utilized for all required course exams and can be accessed on campus or remotely based on cohort needs. These fees also provide a savings to the student compared to individual personal purchases.

Platinum Planning: These proposed fees replace the individual purchase of the required FSDAP clinical scheduling/documentation program at a significant savings to the student. In addition, it consolidates multiple reporting requirements into one program, which provides a more user-friendly platform for students, faculty, and staff and is also a monetary savings for the department.

Reel Dx: This proposed fee is for a program that provides over 700 peer-reviewed medical video cases delivered effectively for more than 1,000 topics. Reel Dx would be of critical importance in the event that the campus is shut down as it can be accessed remotely or on campus. This program would be a highly valuable learning tool should we once again experience the lack of clinical sites for the students' internships.

Physical Therapy: The proposed new program lab fee will cover personal protective equipment, pillowcases, exam table paper and electrodes.

BUDGETARY CONSIDERATION

Many of the required lab supplies are consumable items that cannot be reused from semester to semester or even class to class. These requested lab fees will offset the cost of consumable items used by students.

The EMSP fees will assist in maintaining the high standards of learning and testing tools at a savings to the department and students.


