# Purpose of the Programs

## Extended School Year (ESY) Purpose:

- Provide students in receipt of special education and related services educational opportunities designed to prevent regression, minimize recoupment time upon return to school, and to provide consistent environment for learning.
- Students recommended for direct and/or related services 1-5 days each week July 6 - July 31
- In-person or distance learning program options

## Summer School Purpose:

- Provide opportunities for credit recovery for students with final grades of 64% or below at DMS, DHS, and RAISE Academy.
- Students afforded opportunity for in-person, socially distanced tutoring Monday - Thursday, July 6 - July 30

# Overview

## Transportation

- Students submit ahead of bus arrival/drop-off (via Google Forms), daily health screening document and student temperature OR provide hard copies upon boarding to staff
- Paraeducators monitor appropriate social-distancing, collect daily health screenings, and ensure PPE protocols followed on buses

## Program

- Students participate in learning opportunities aligned with IEP goals & objectives from 9am-12pm daily (or otherwise recommended by PPT)
- Students are socially distanced and maintain PPE throughout their day
- Program housed in one wing (including summer school) of DMS

## Materials

- All students provided all materials needed each day (students not bringing any materials, food, drink, etc. from home)
- All devices are cleaned and sanitized following each use

# ESY and Summer School Staffing

## ESY

- DMS/DHS Distance Learning: One teacher; one paraeducator
- DMS/DHS In-Person: One teacher; two paraeducators
- Irving/Bradley Distance Learning: Two teachers; two paraeducators
- Irving/Bradley In-Person: two teachers; four paraeducators

## Summer School

- DMS: One teacher
- DHS: One teacher

Join us at 11am for a fun zoom meeting! We will do some stretching, play the freeze dance game with some cool moves to copy and show and tell!

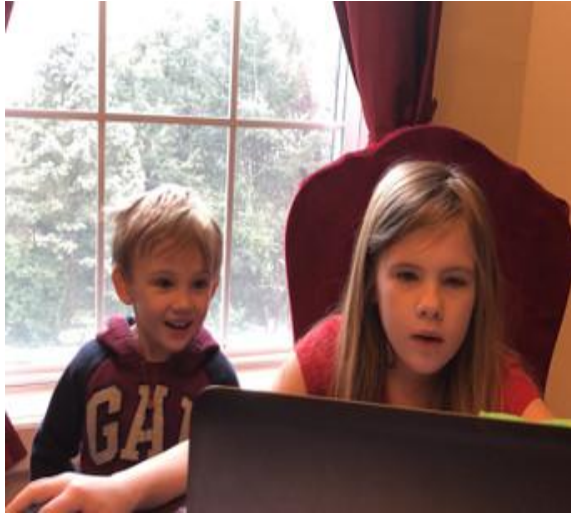
