Background	<p>As required by Board Policy CV(LOCAL), the Board of Trustees approved the Competitive Sealed Proposal (CSP) project delivery/contract award method of procurement for the Crosby Sixth Grade Campus project on February 12, 2018.</p> <p>A legal notice was published in the Baytown Sun on February 3, 2026, and February 10, 2026. A total of seven companies submitted proposals by the deadline on March 19, 2026, which were subsequently evaluated by the District, Stantec Architects, and Lockwood, Andrews & Newnam, Inc. (LAN), based on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Proposed amount for base proposal and owner-selected alternates ● Evaluation survey of company references and project controls ● History of company performance ● Similar company project experience and qualifications ● Similar individual personnel project experience and qualifications <p>Gamma Construction Company was the number one ranked proposer and has been determined to provide the best value to Crosby ISD.</p>
