Spring 2021 review of curriculum scope and sequence delivered across the year



K-8 vertical articulation across content areas to communicate learning patterns and trends



Engaged in summer work to refine instruction and develop assessments to prepare for Fall



Review of standardized data by independent data consultant to assess student growth, achievement, and any significant impact across all stakeholder groups




Facilitate teacher collaborative review of classroom-based data

Providing a Targeted Response

Review	Review formative assessments across units as they are taught to adjust instruction as needed
Embed	Embed content review from previous years to reinforce concepts and connect to new learning
Provide	Provide timely feedback to students through 1:1 conferencing
Continue	Continue Multi-Tiered Systems of Support
Initiate	Initiate additional supports as needs surface: Early Elementary Interventions, AM Academy
Provide	Provide balance of acceleration and remediation
