- Illinois Science Assessment (1x per year) - grades 5 & 8

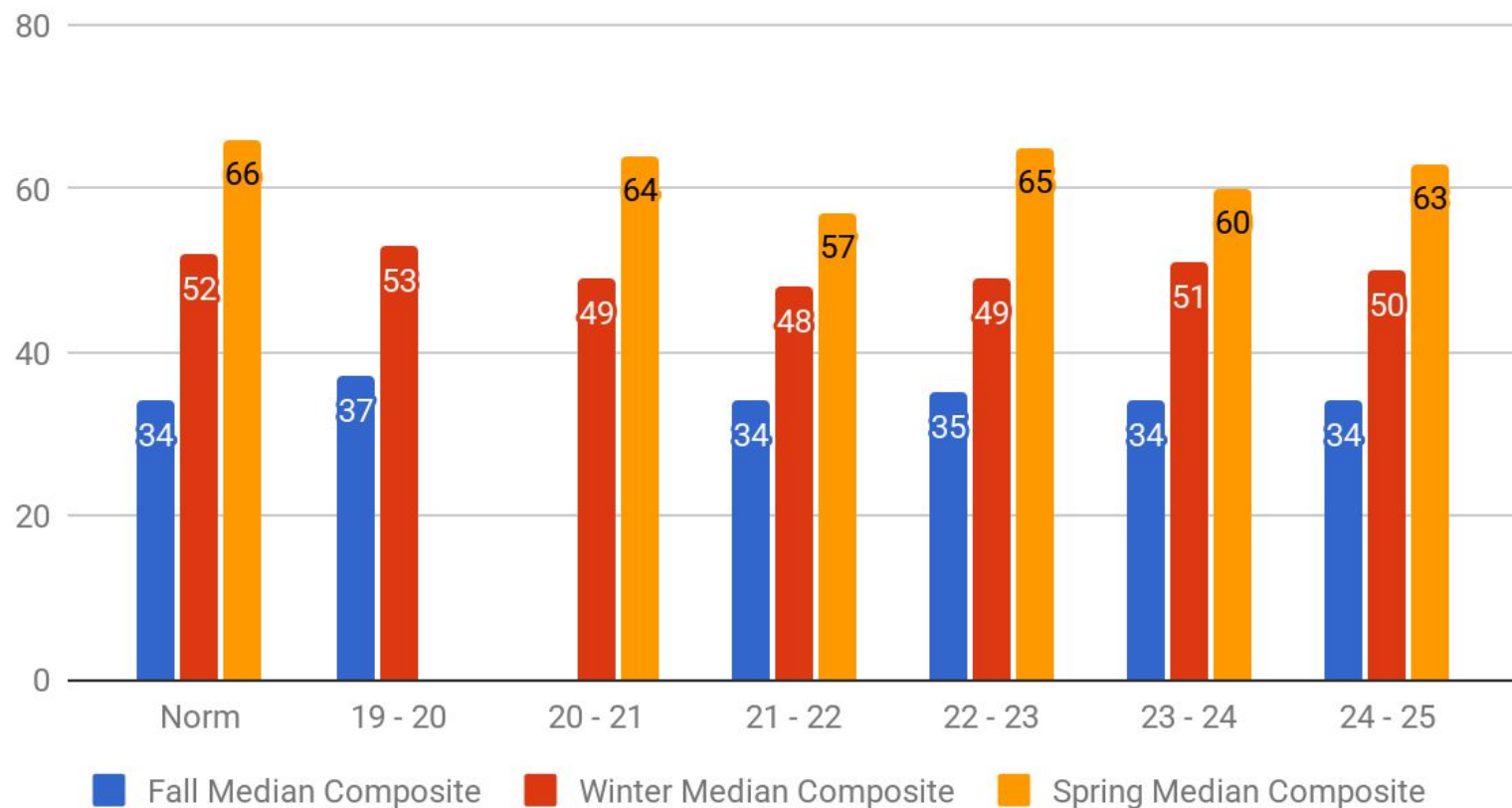
IAR Update

Illinois Assessment of Readiness

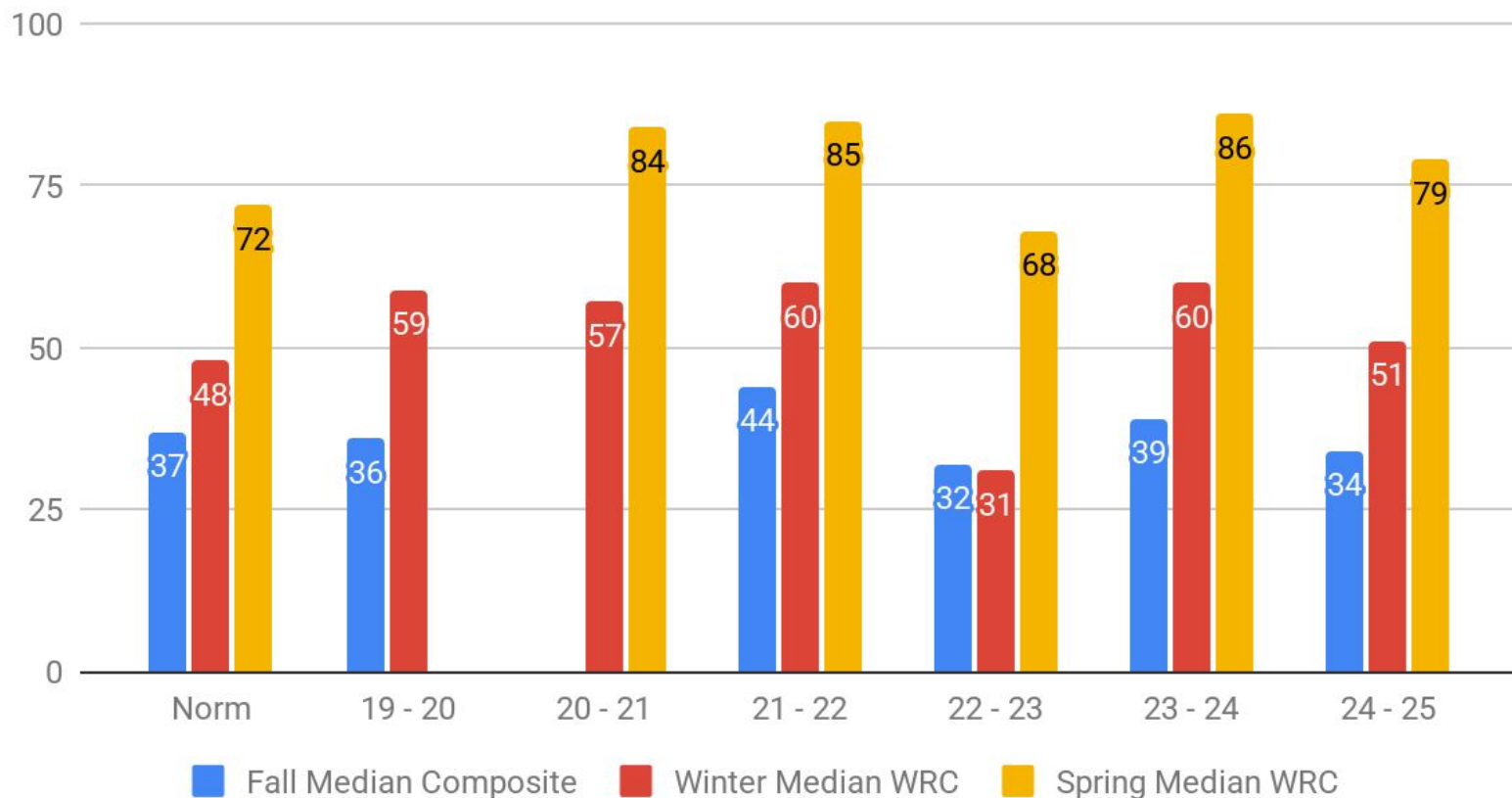
- Received information from the State on Wednesday, June 18th
 - Preliminary Raw Scores became available today
 - State committee is reanalyzing the cut scores in mid-July and will have new parameters for groupings.
 - The Illinois State Board will review and potentially approve new groupings in August
 - We will have new grouping parameters for the data in August/September
 - What does this mean - test didn't change but the achievement bars will.

FastBridge Reading Achievement by Grade Level

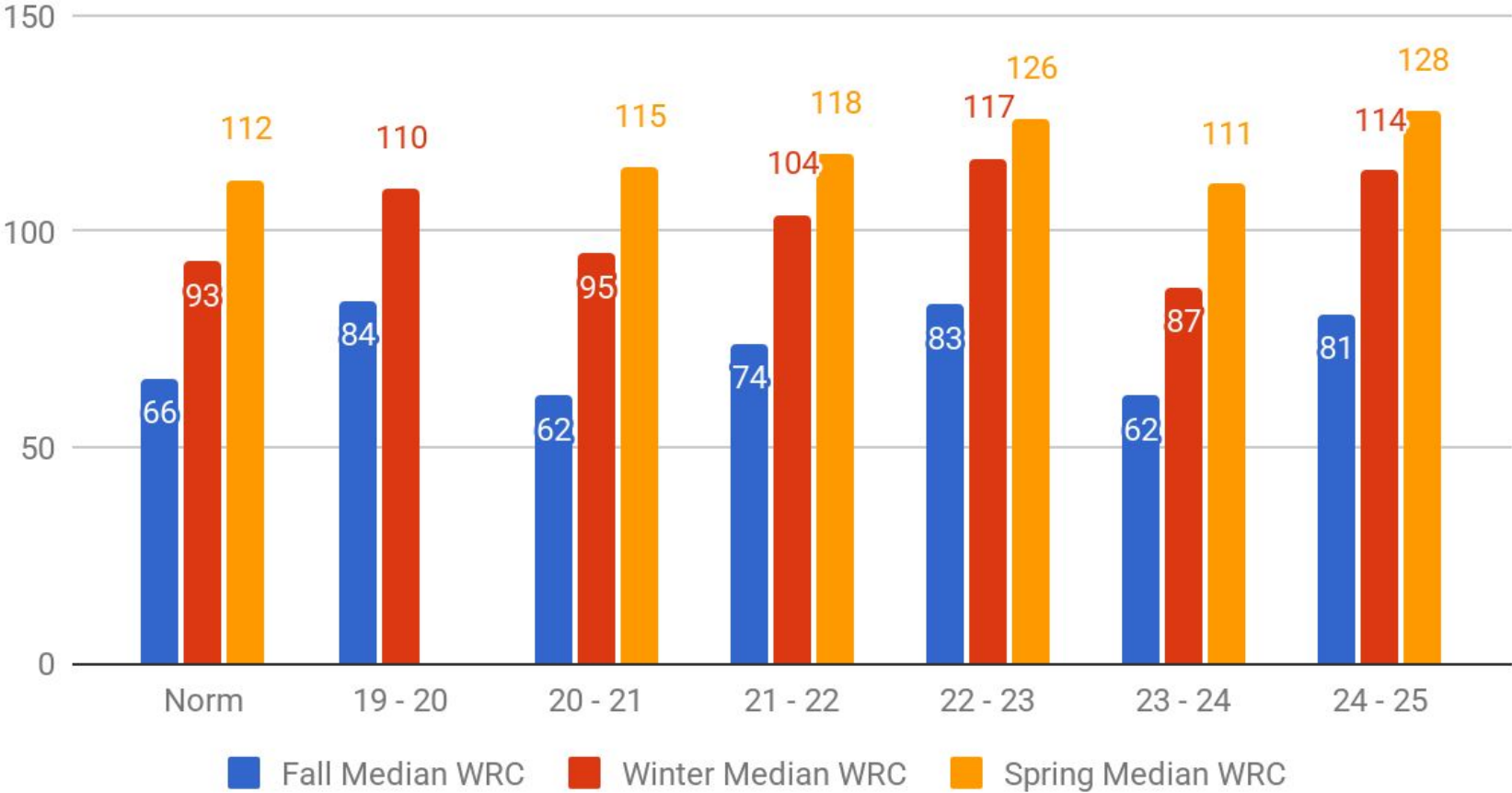
Kindergarten Early Reading Median Composite



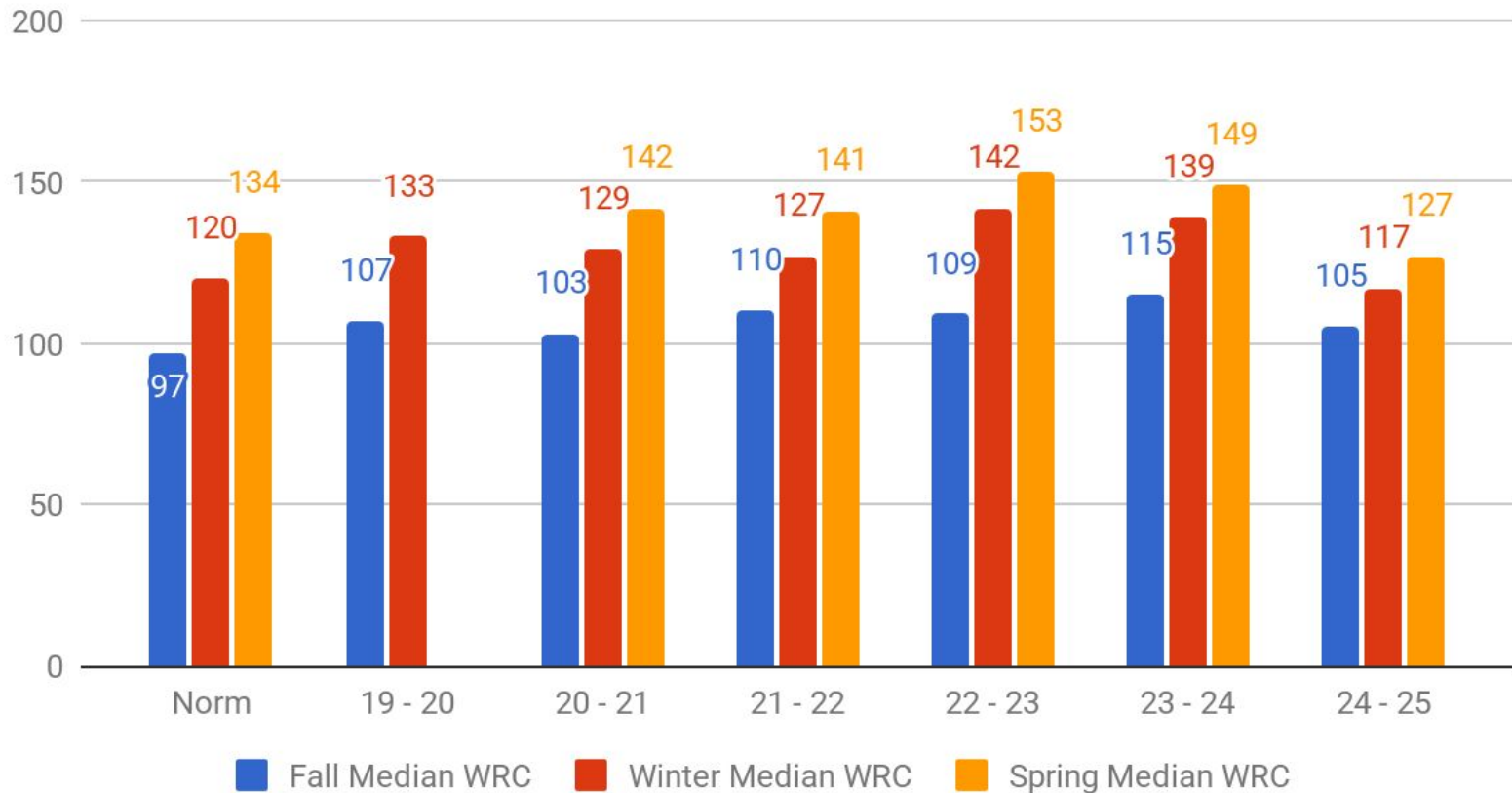
1st Grade Median Words Read Correct



2nd Grade Median Words Read Correct

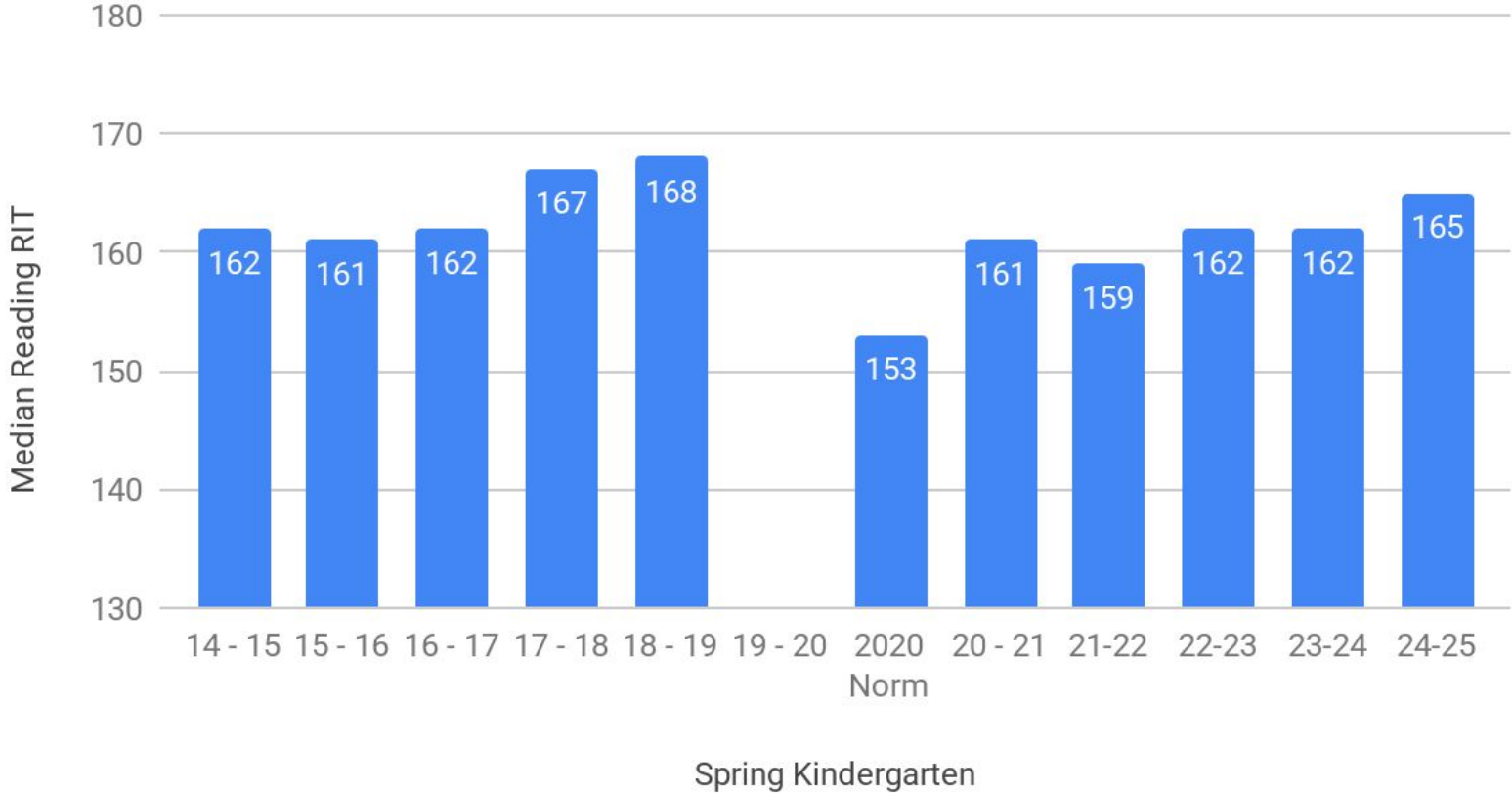


3rd Grade Median Words Read Correct

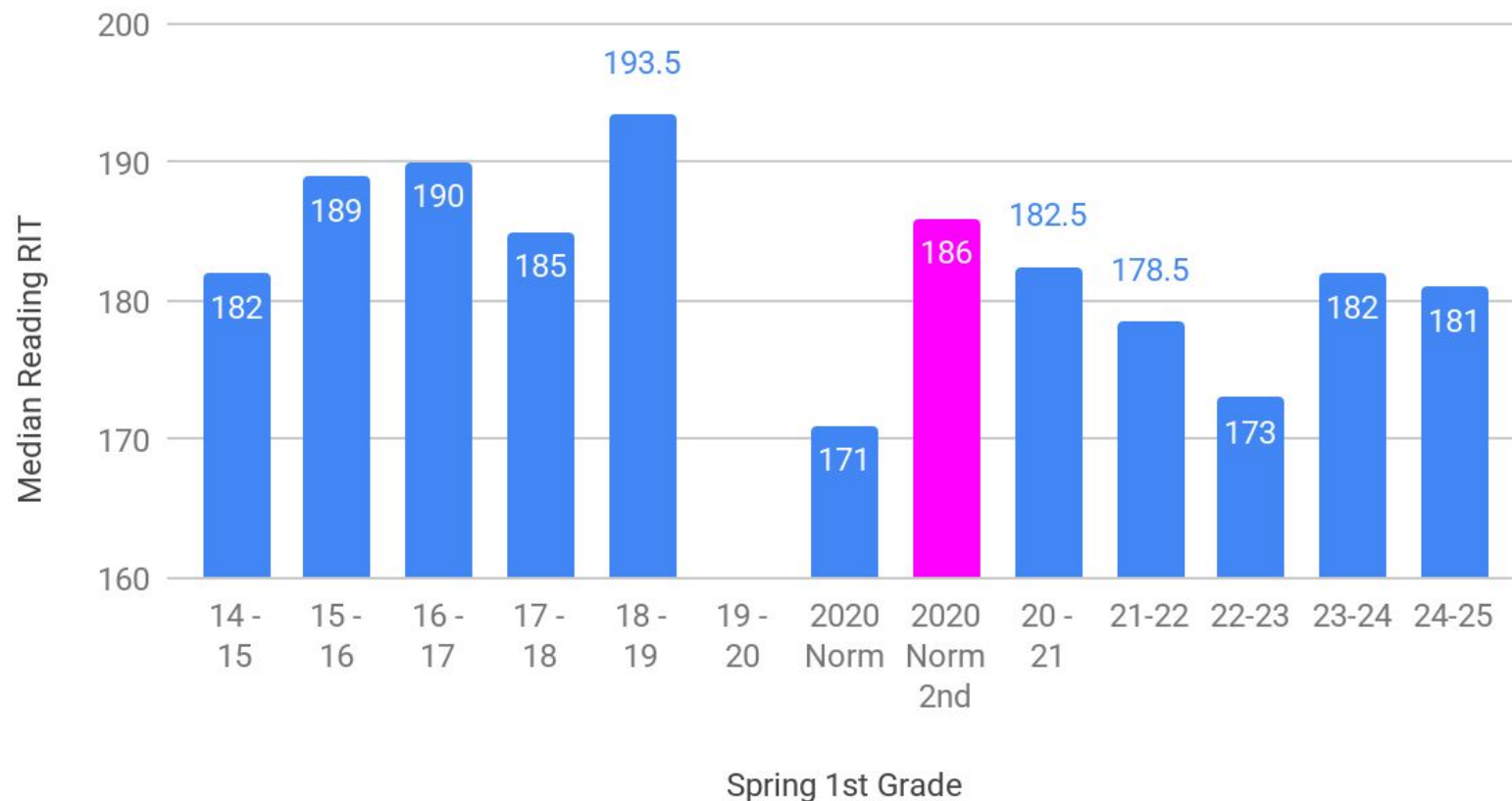

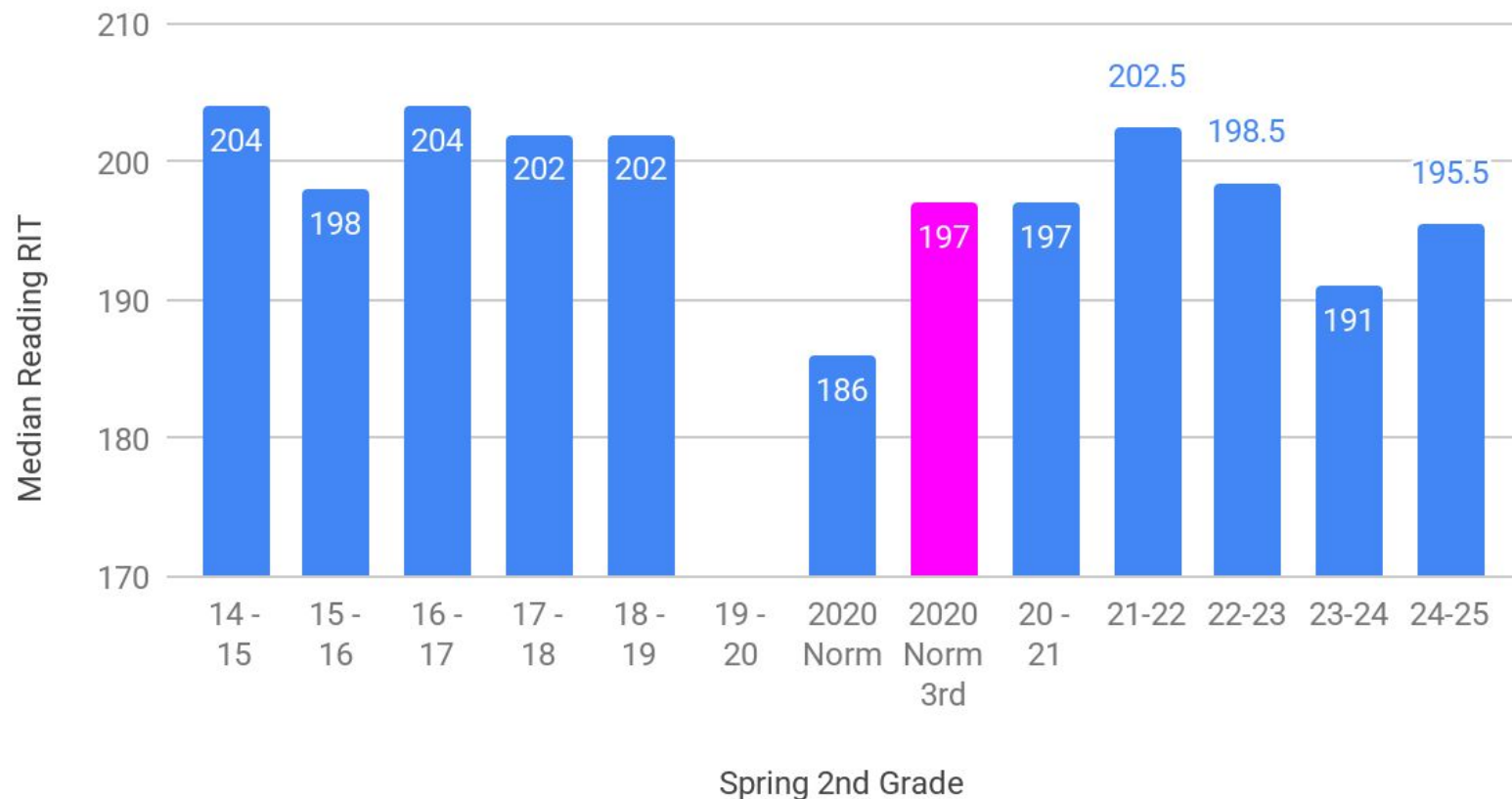

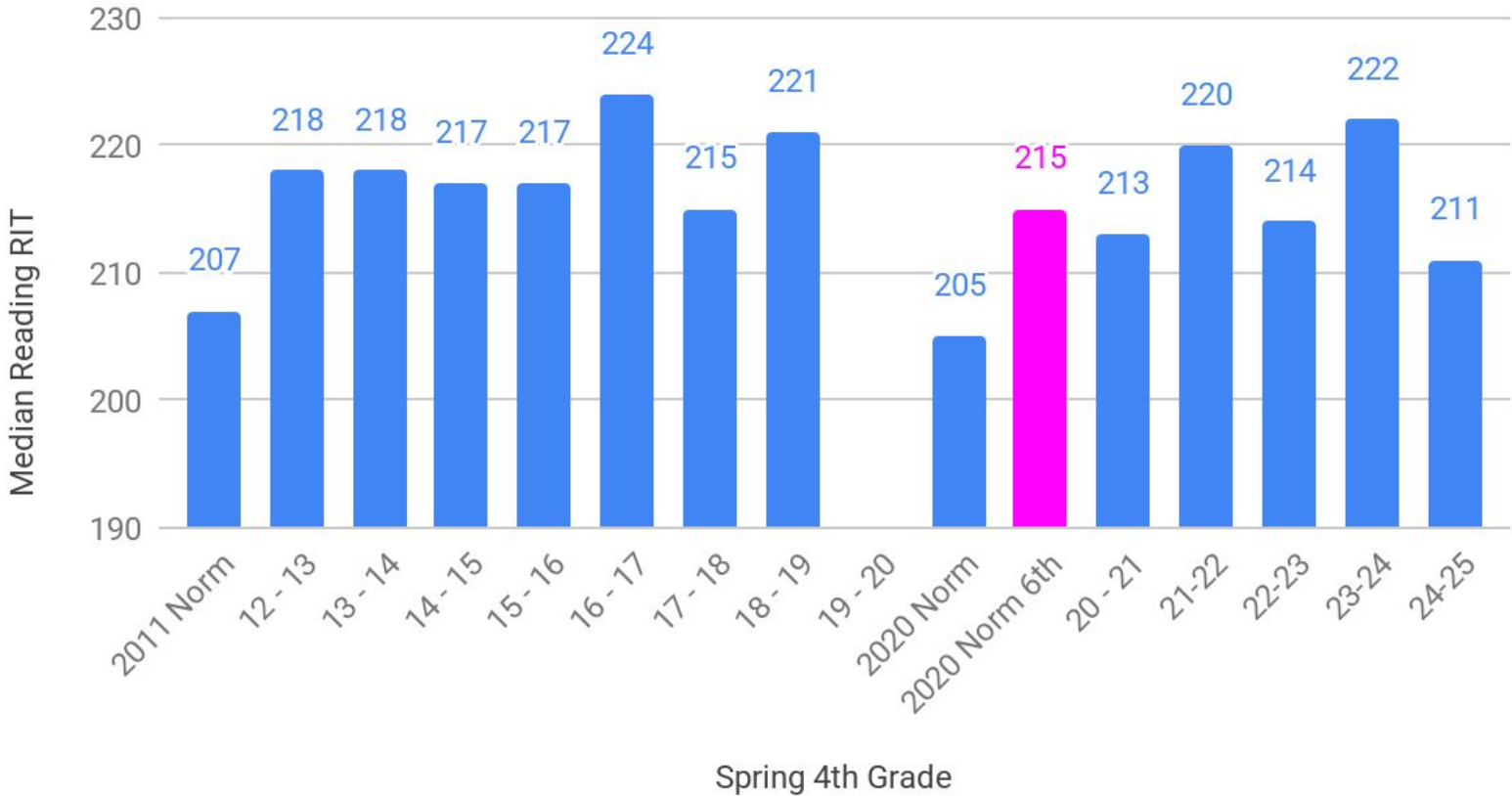

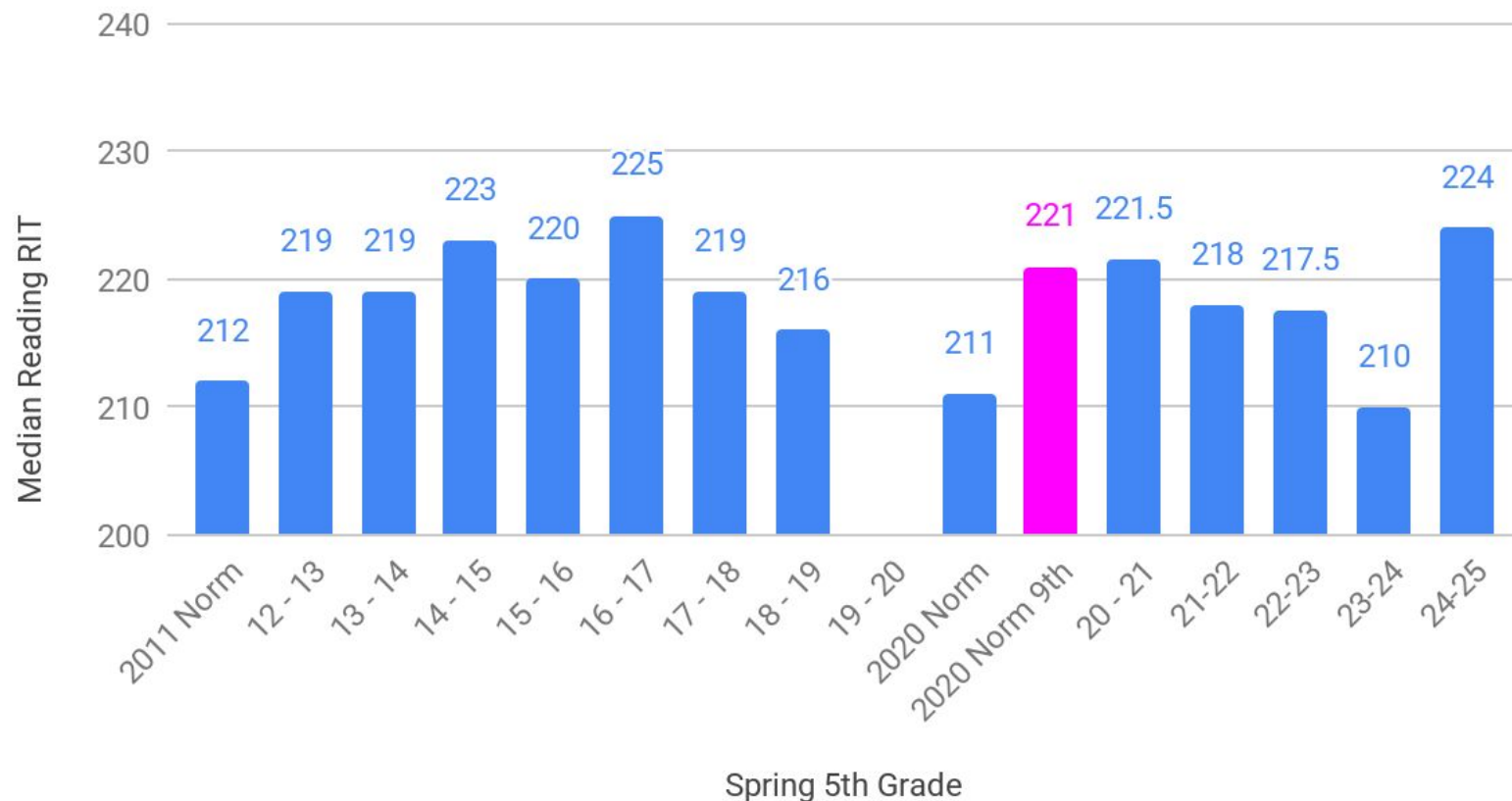

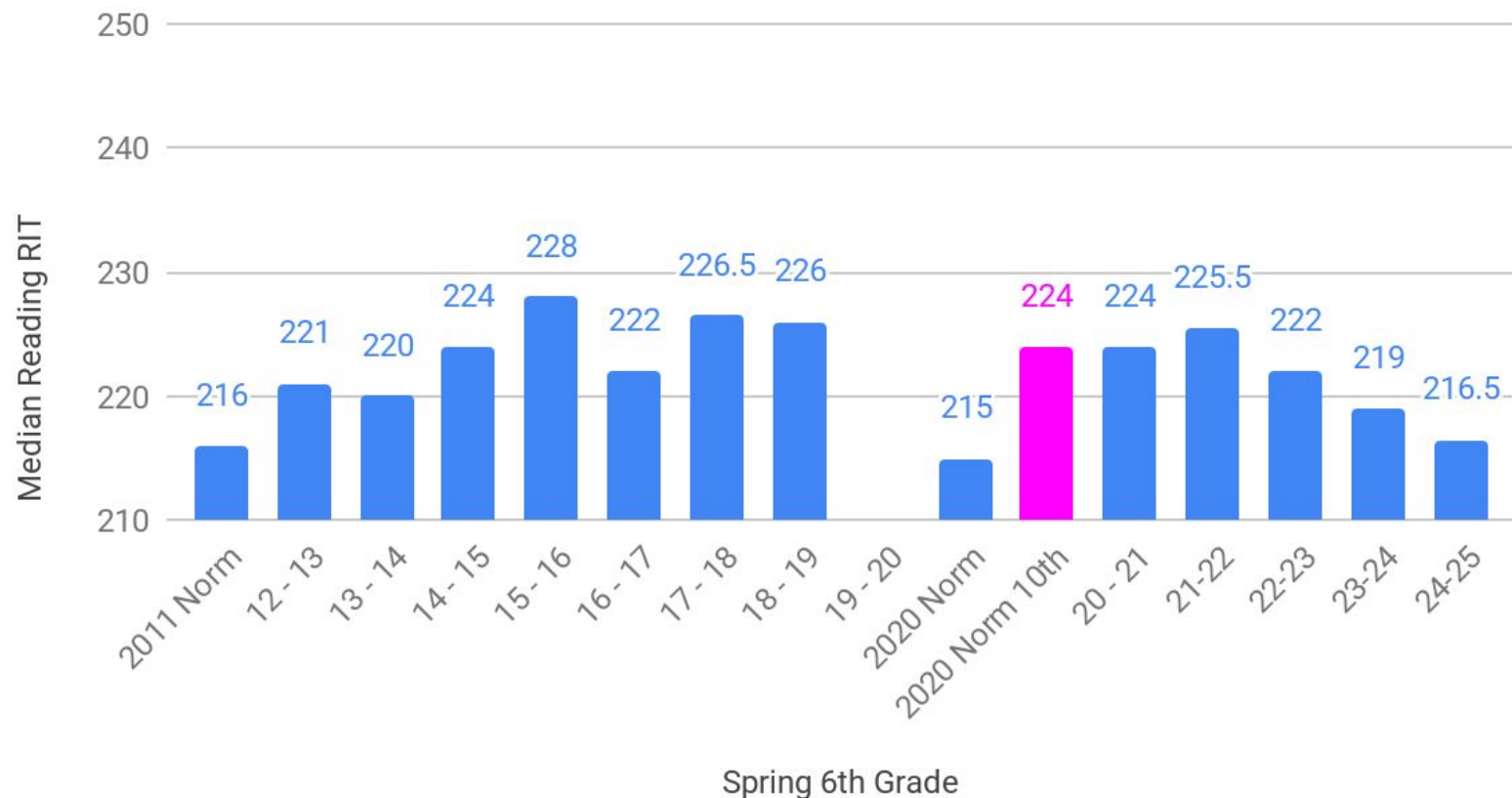

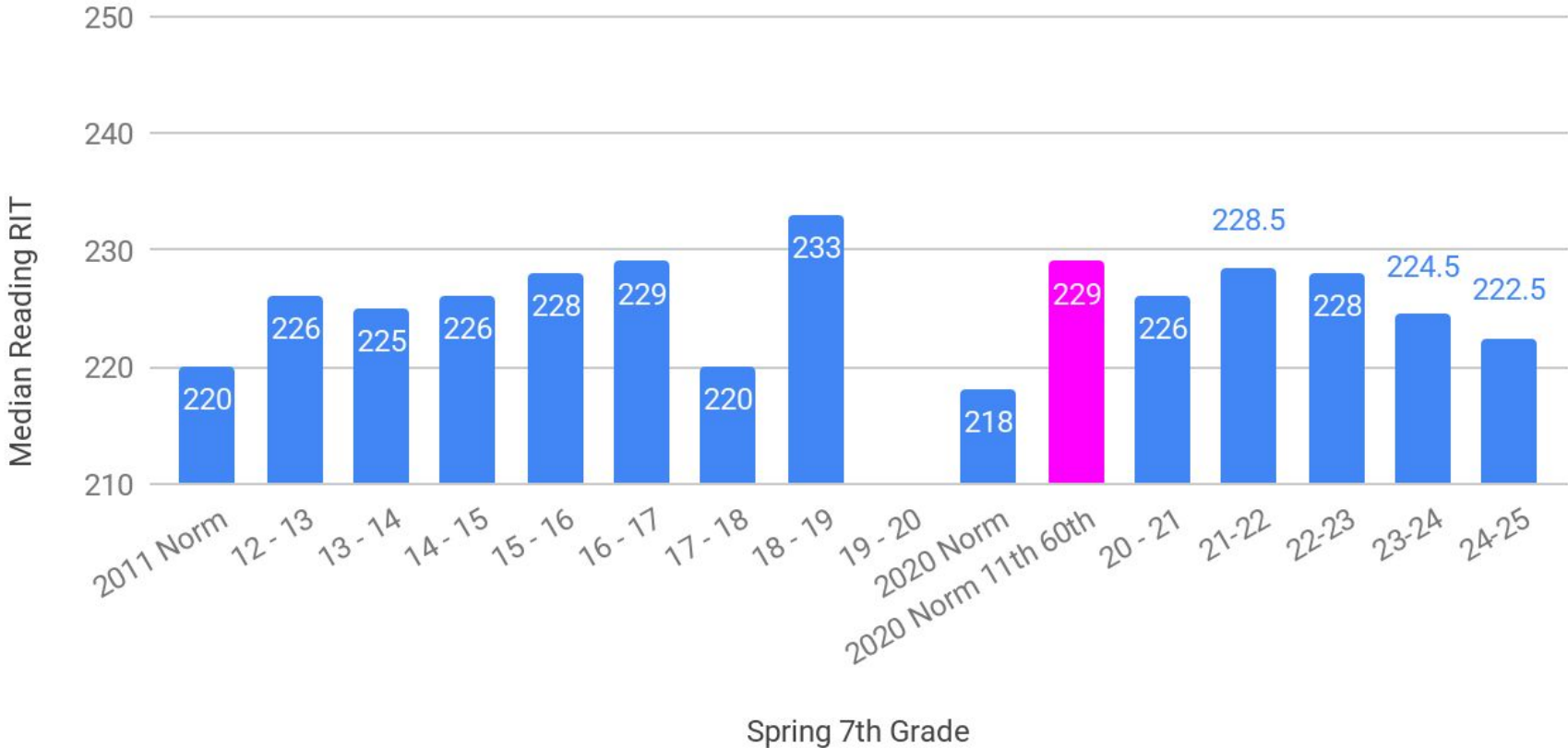

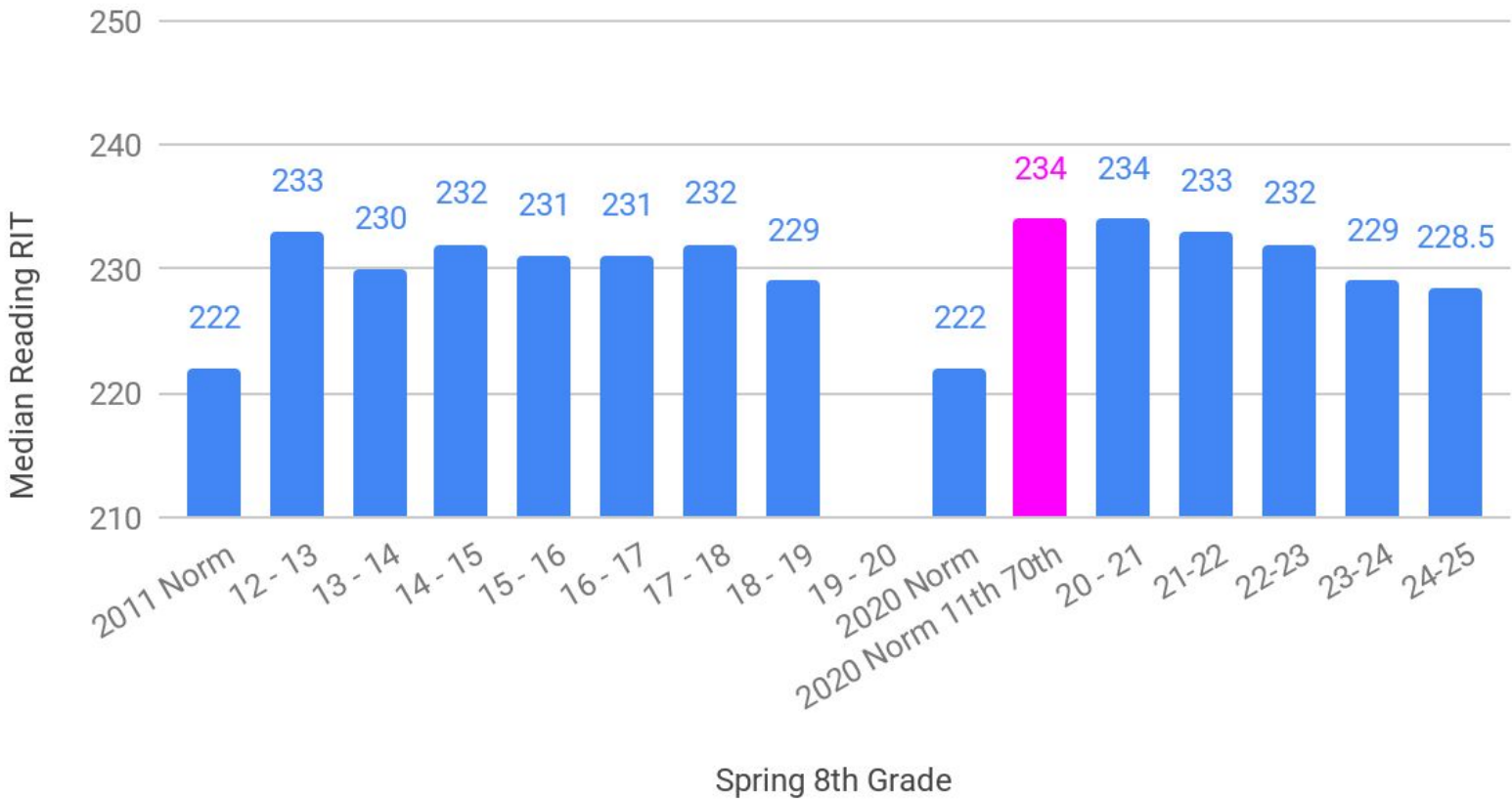

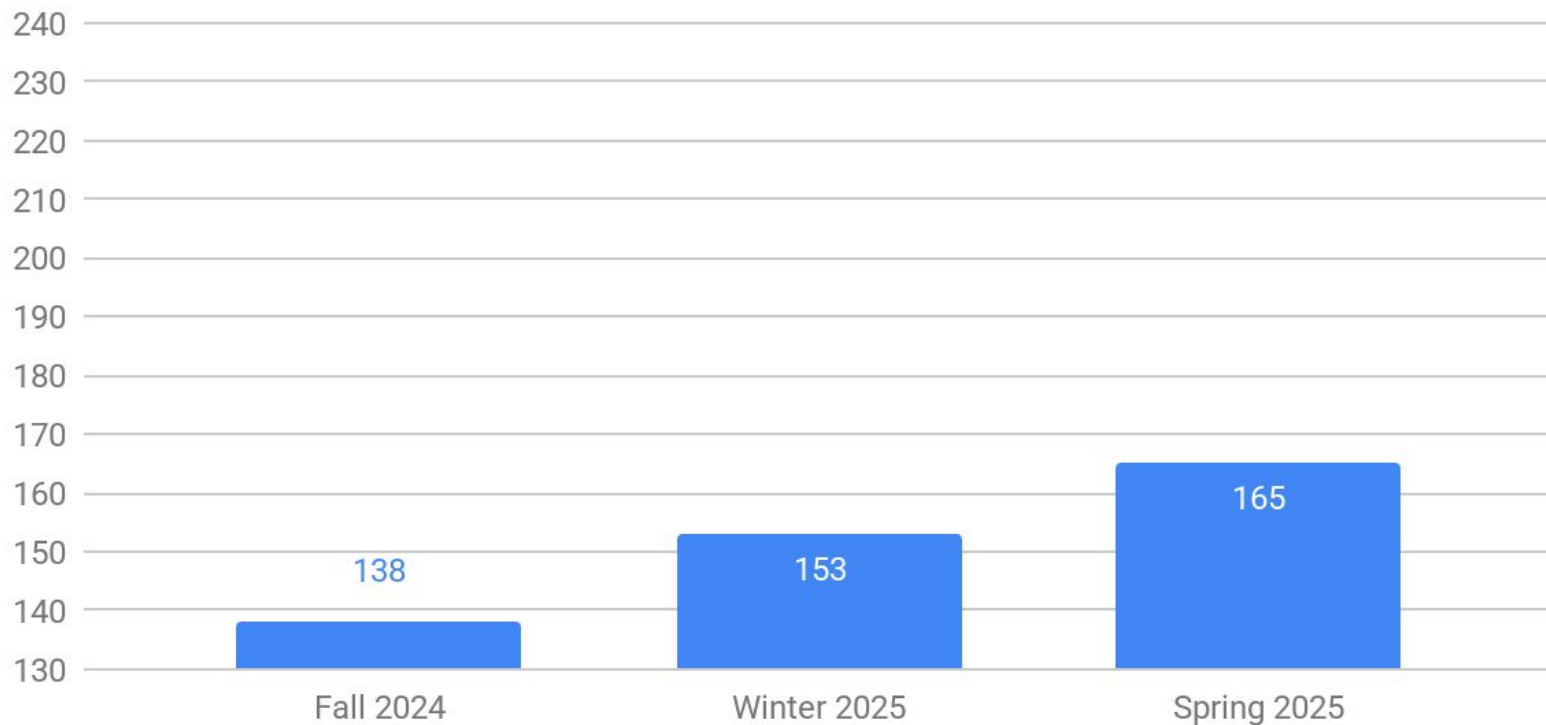

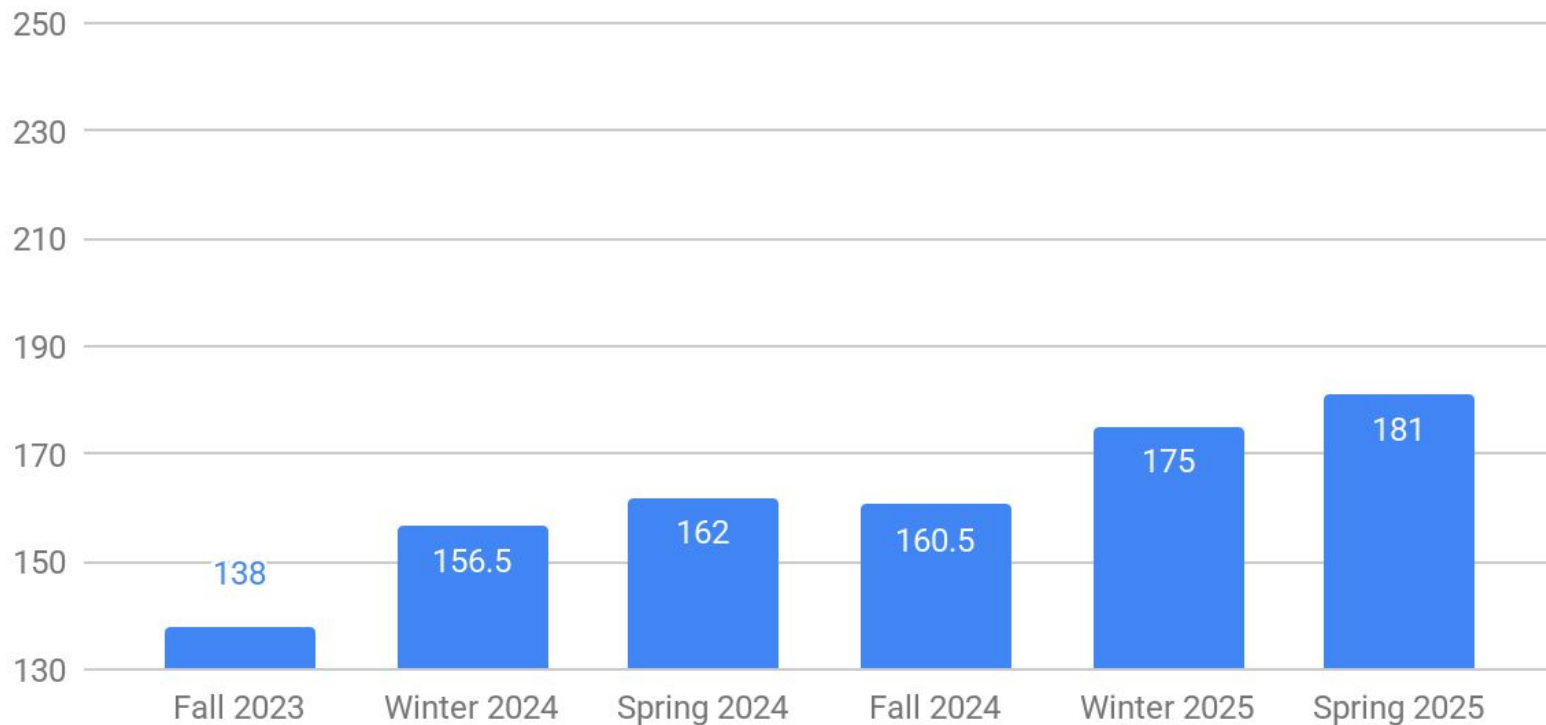

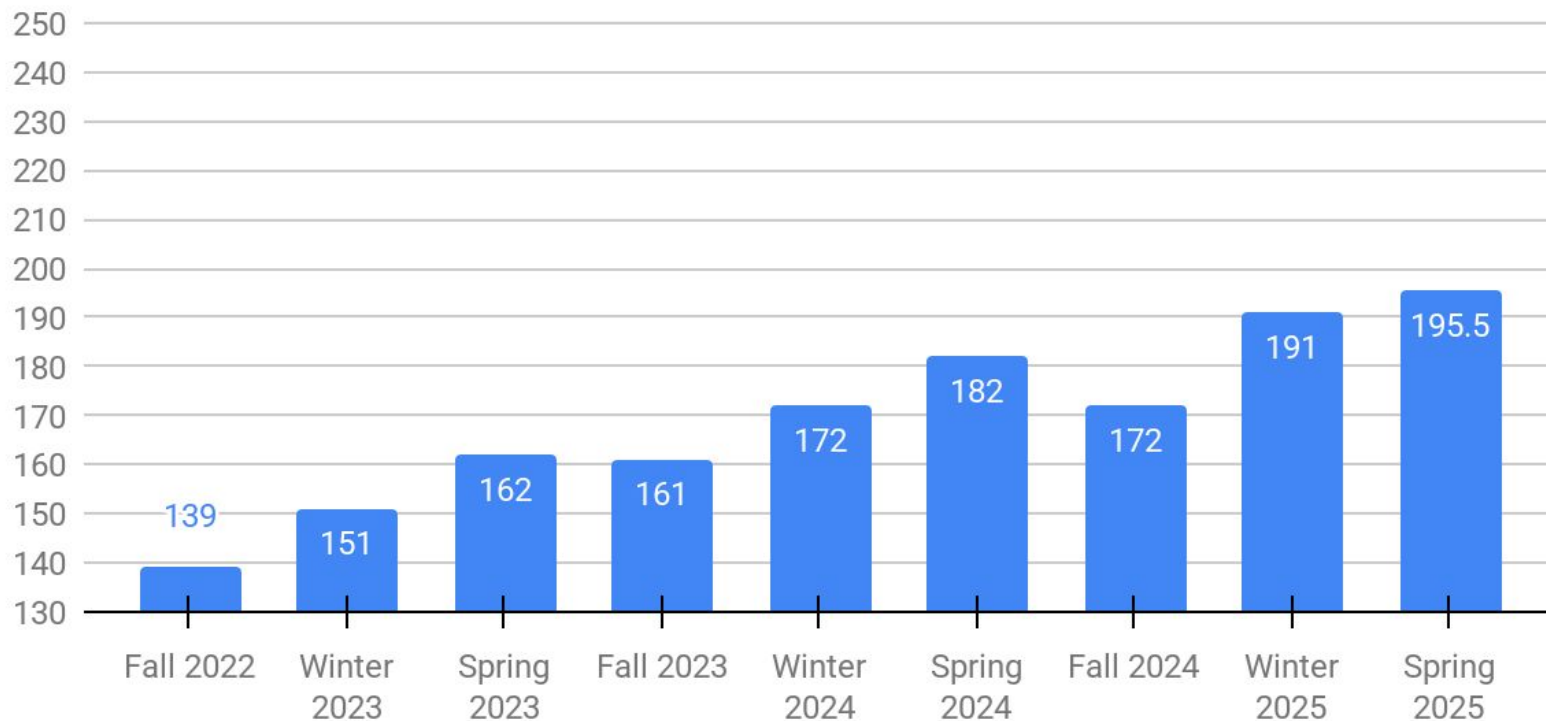

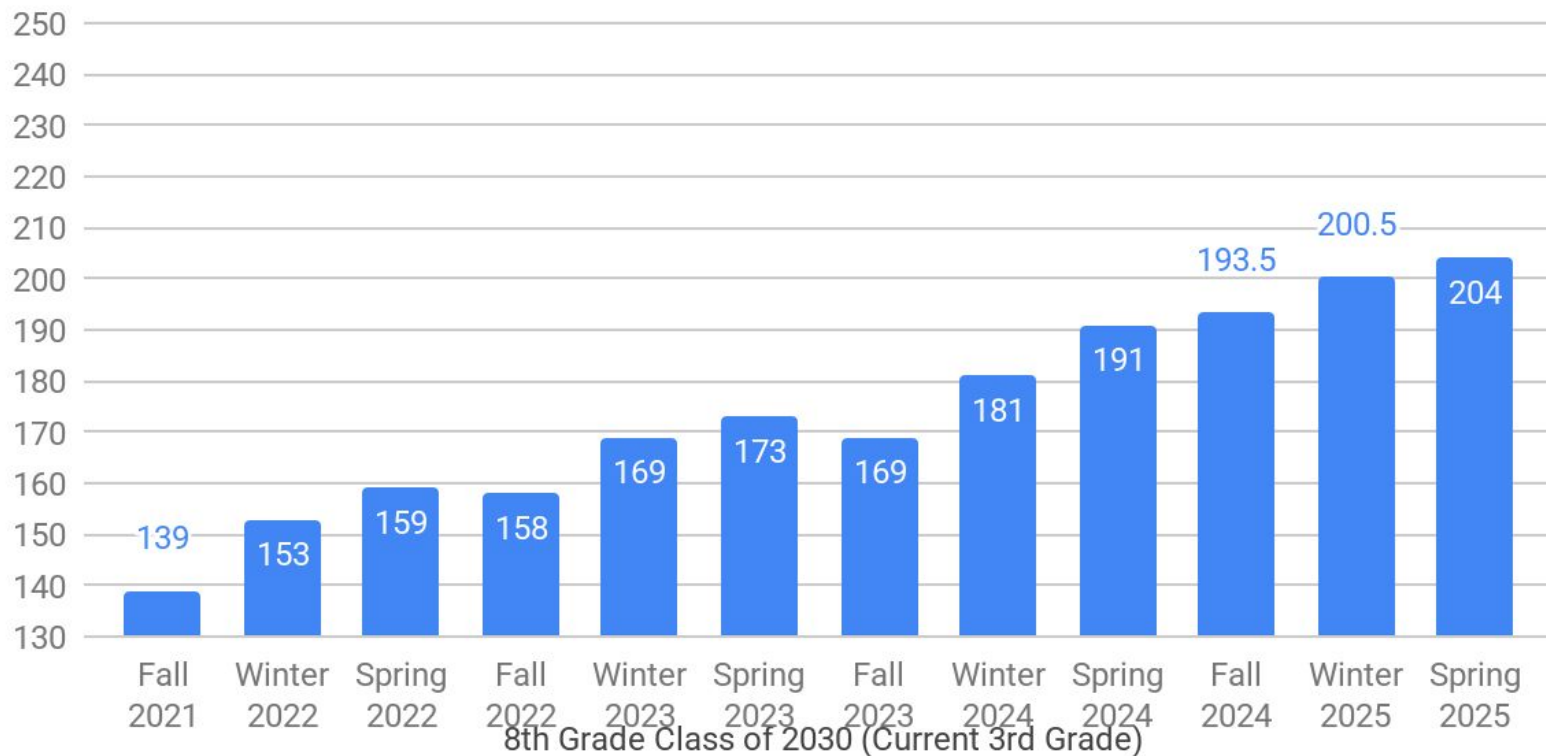

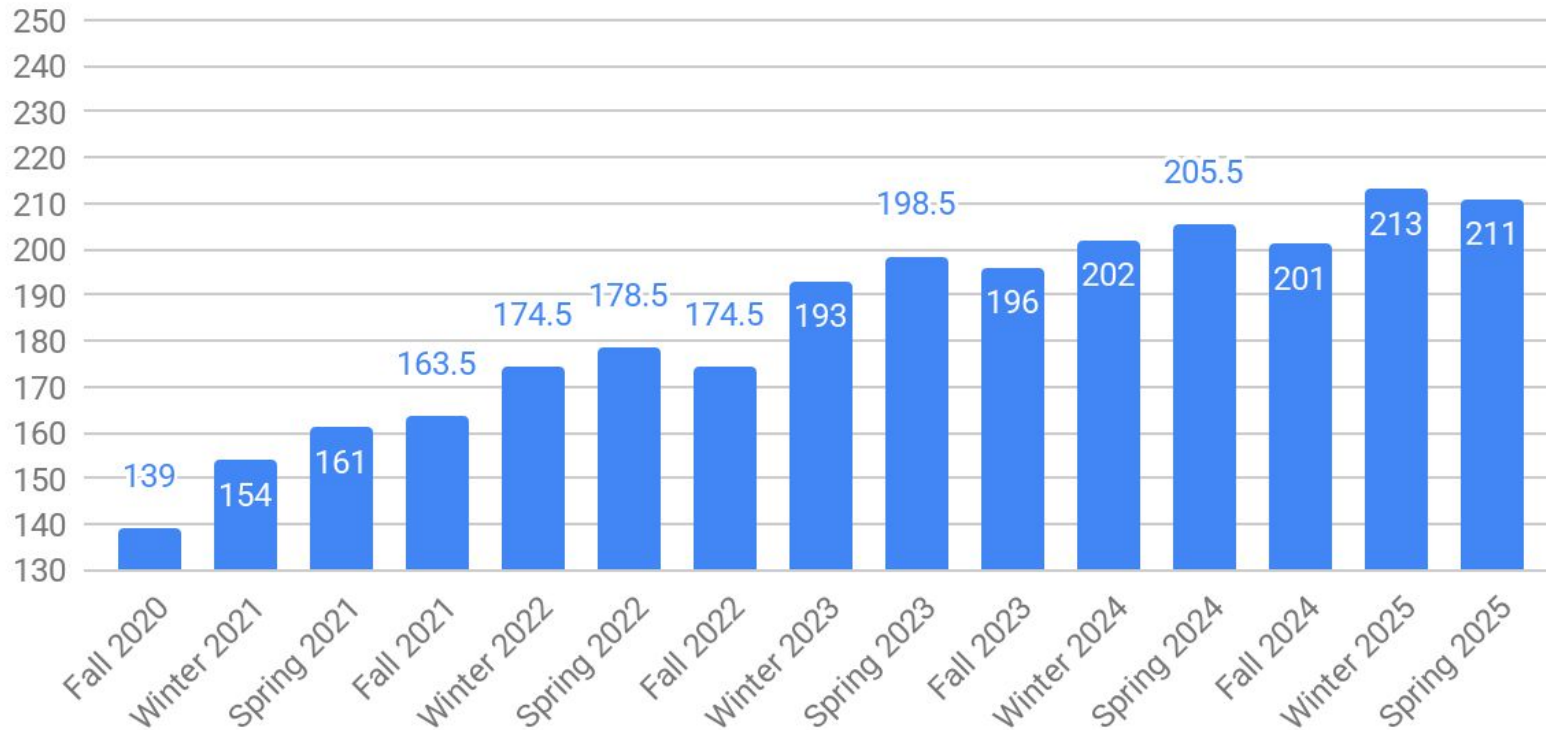

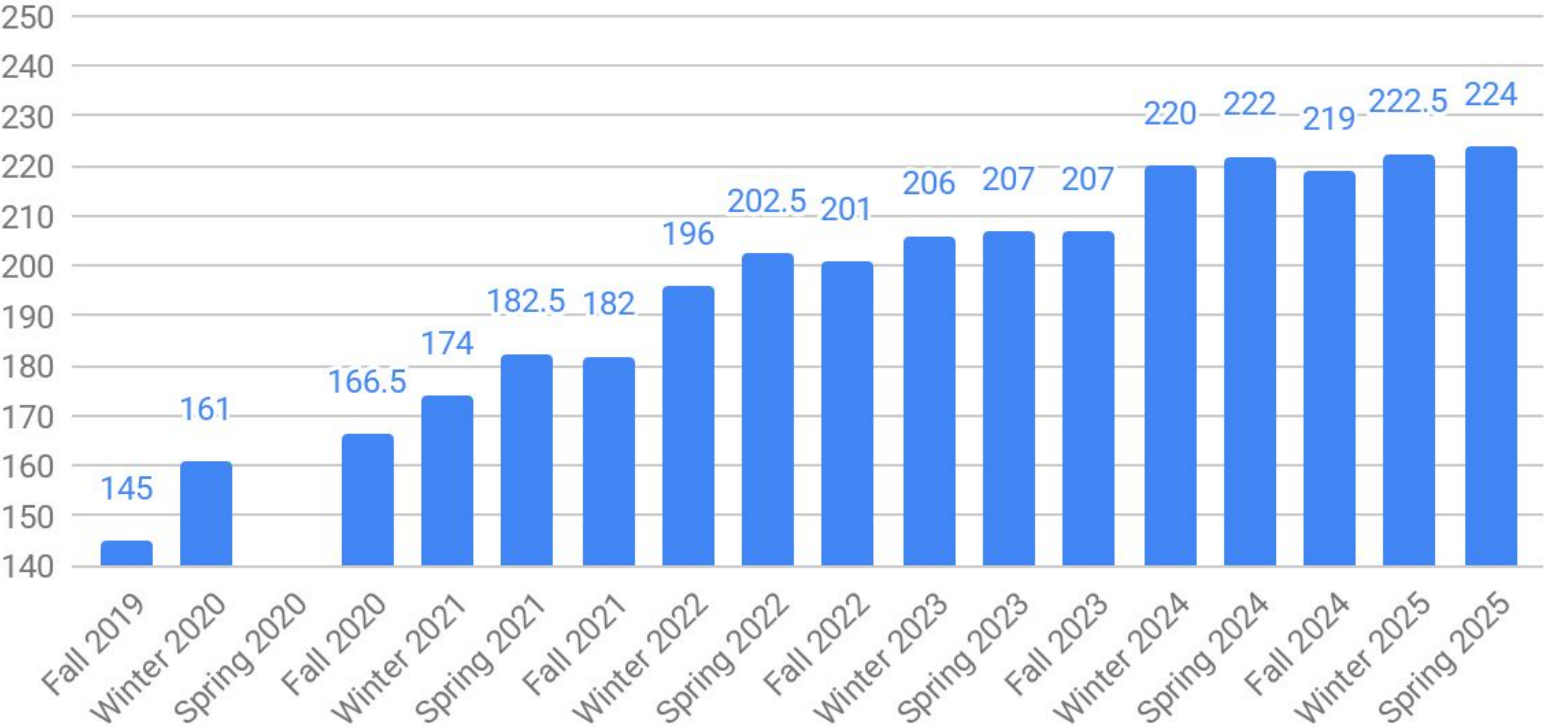

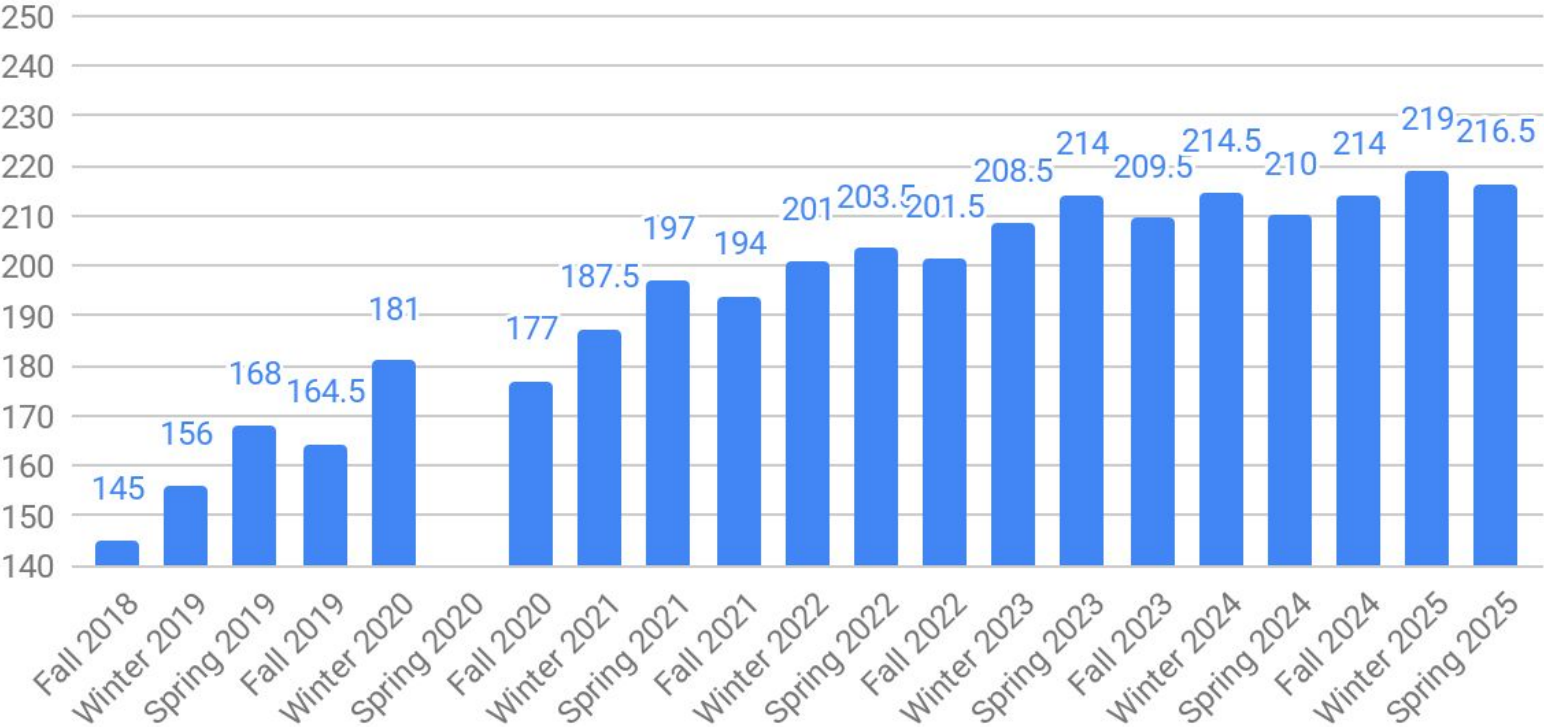

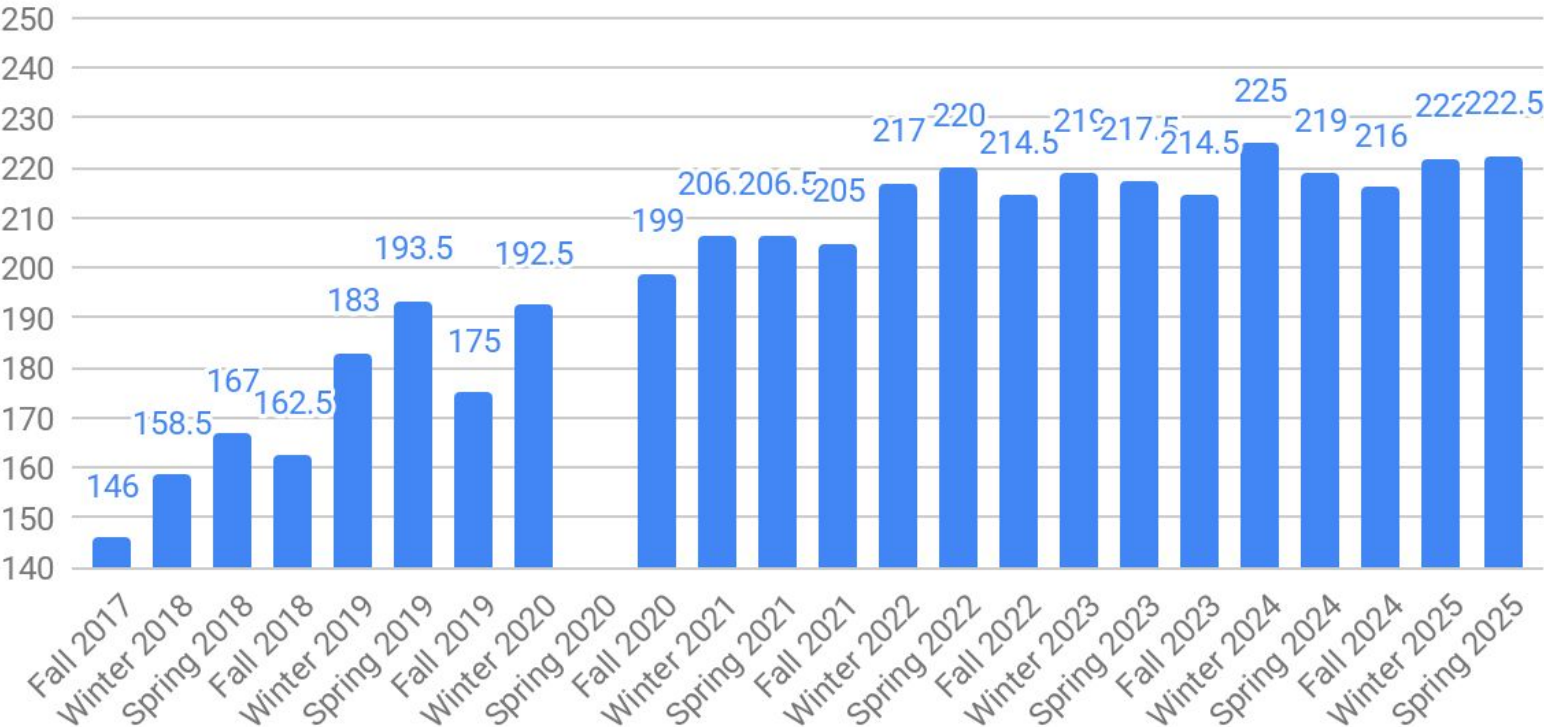

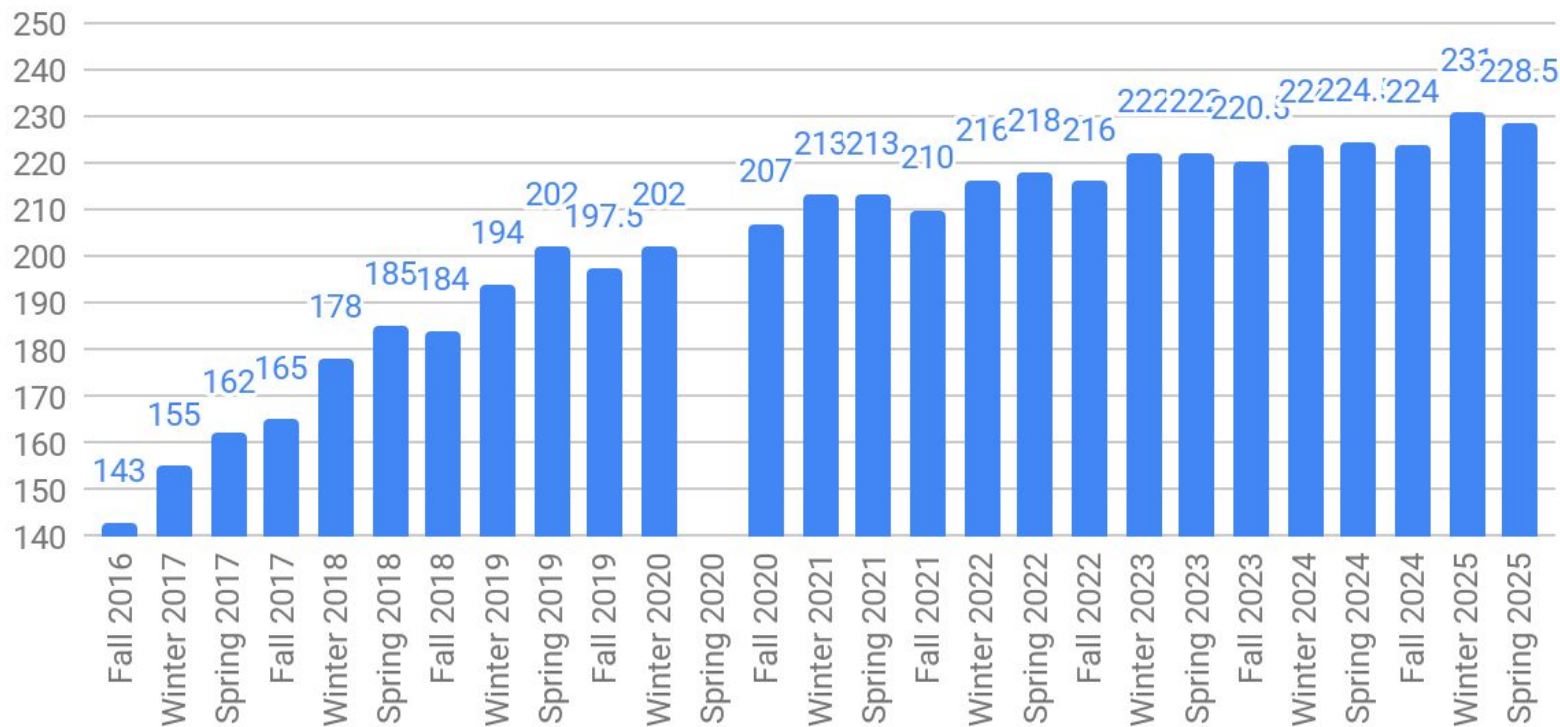

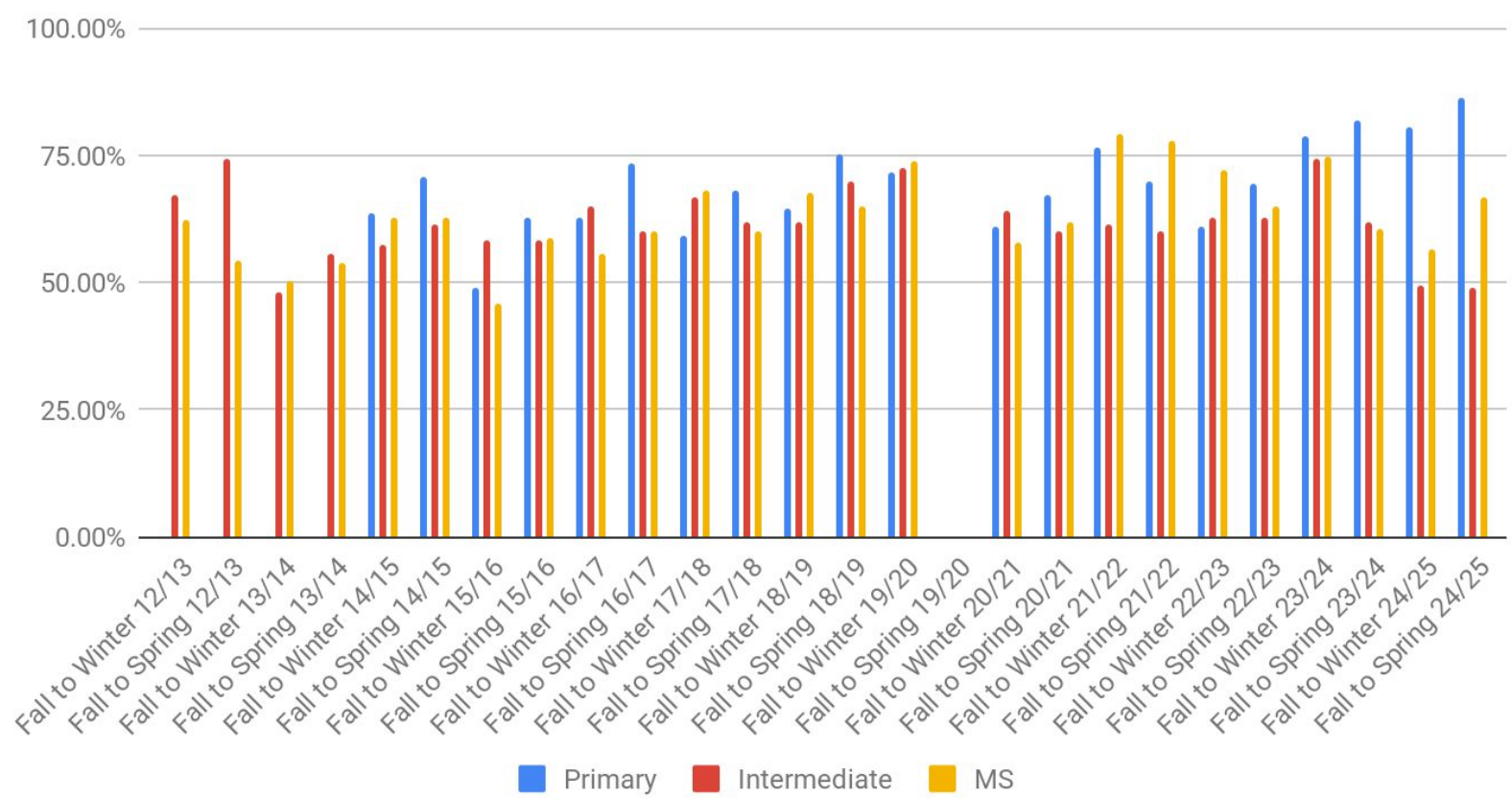

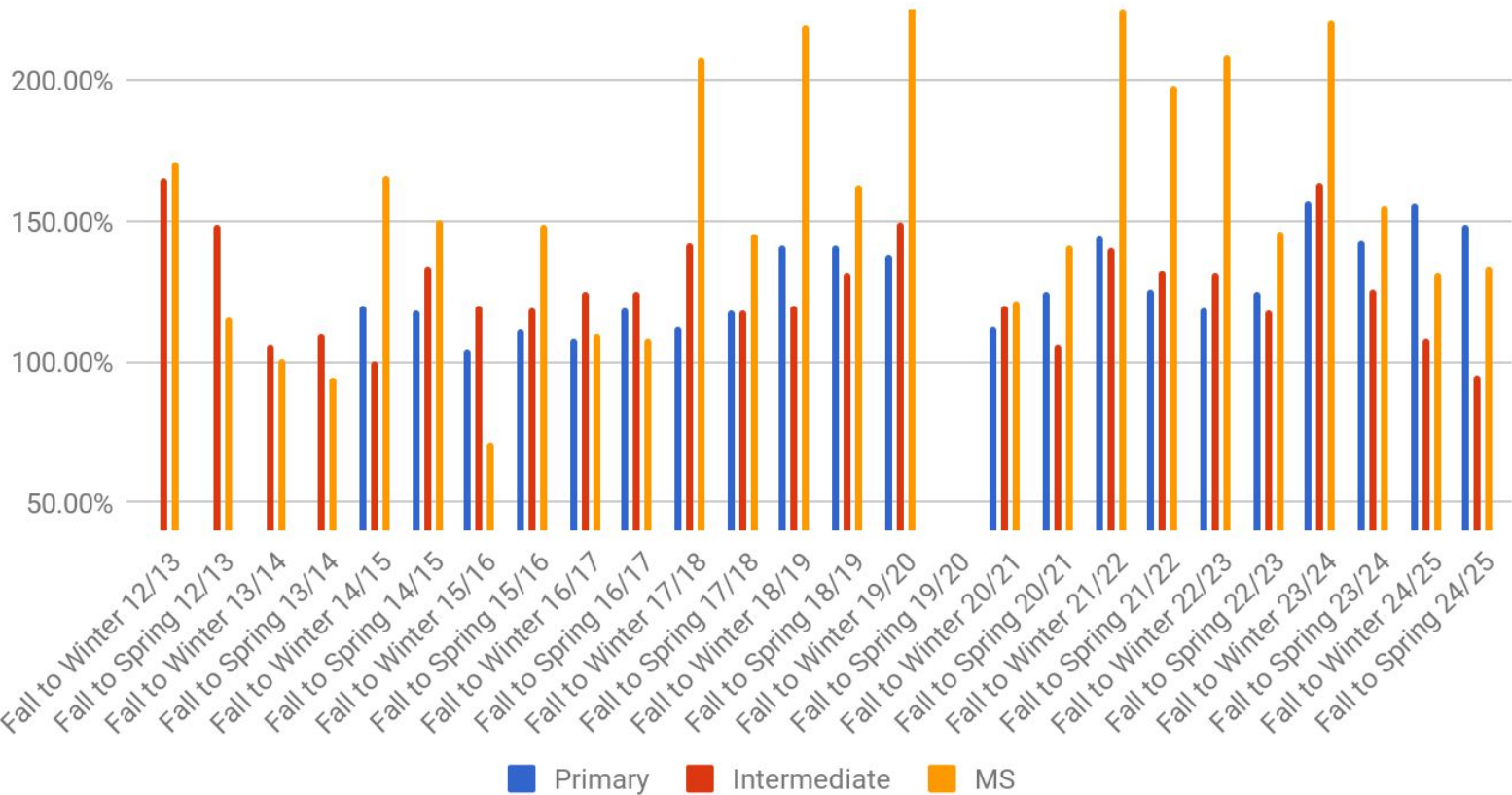

MAP Reading Growth - By Level

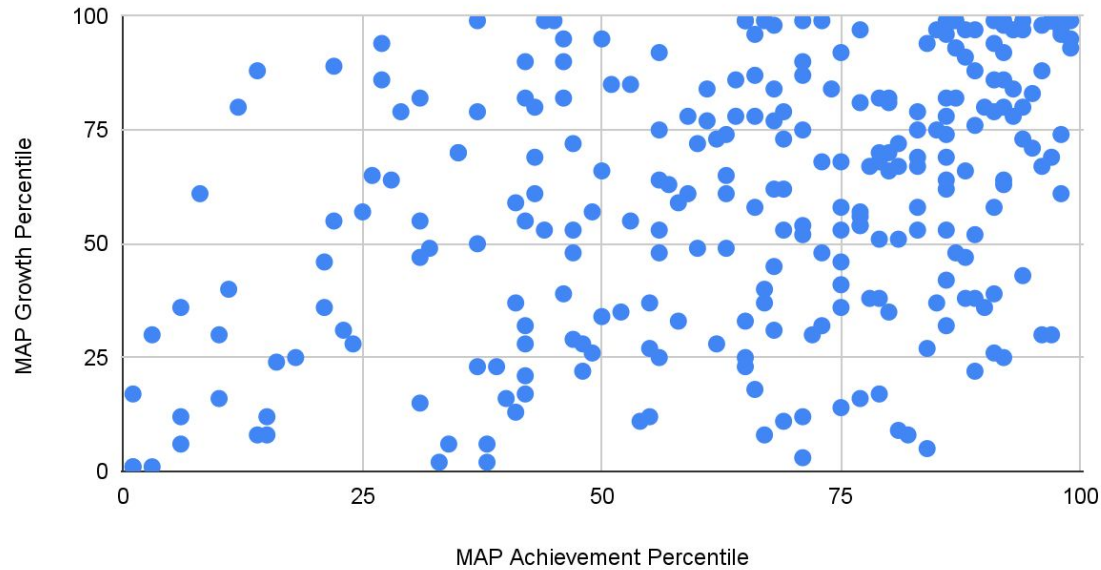
Reading - % of Students Meeting & Exceeding MAP Growth Targets



Reading - % of Growth Compared to Projected MAP Growth Targets



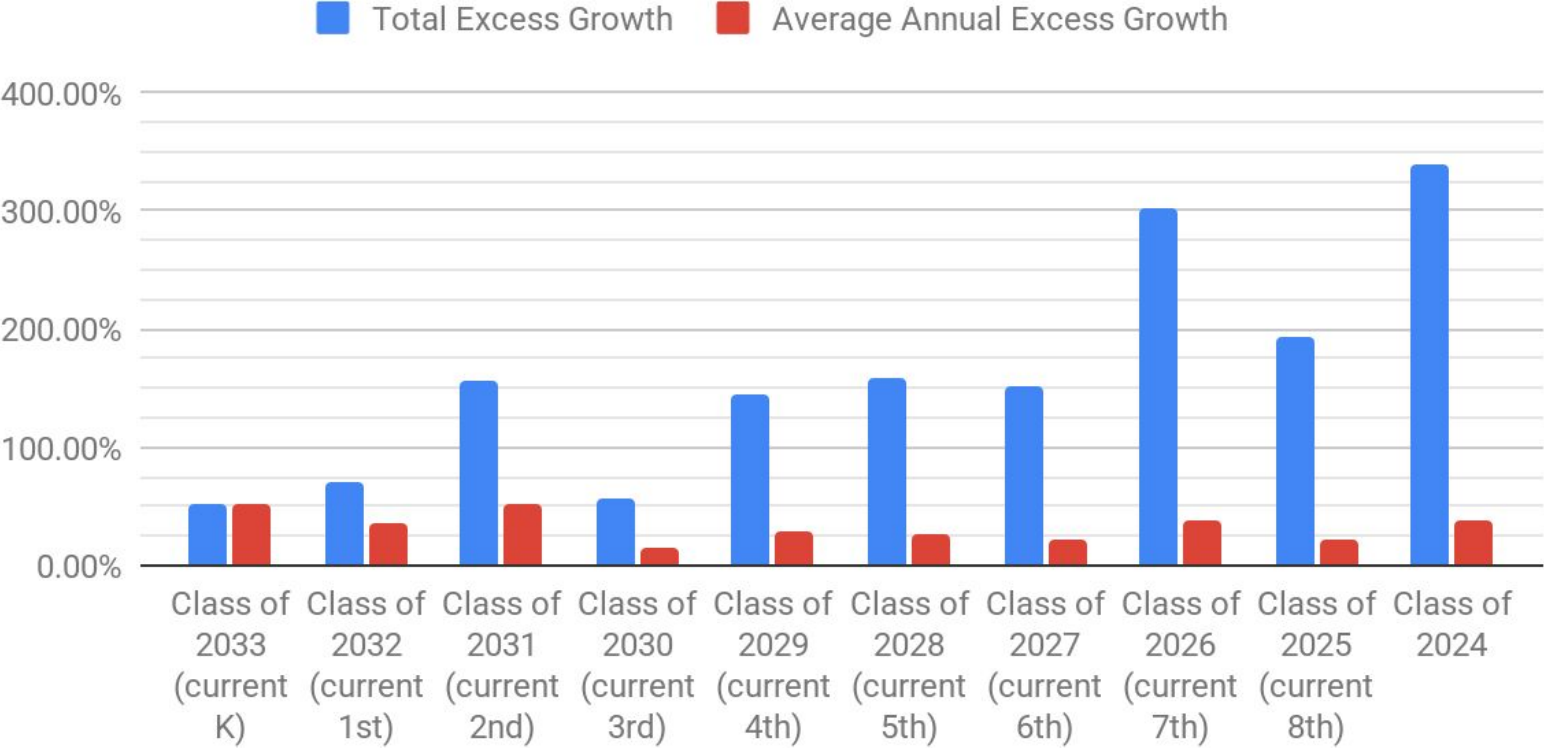

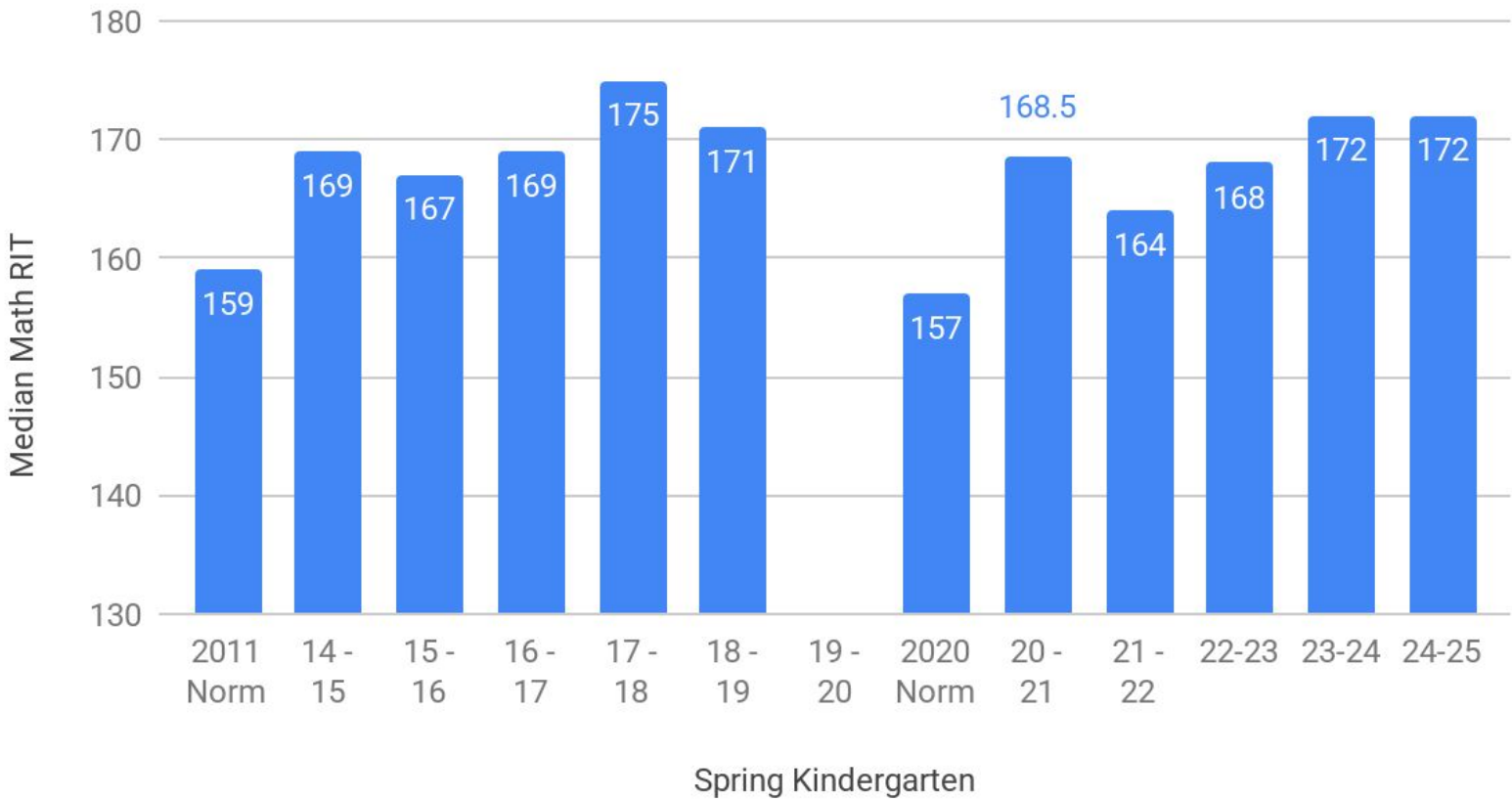

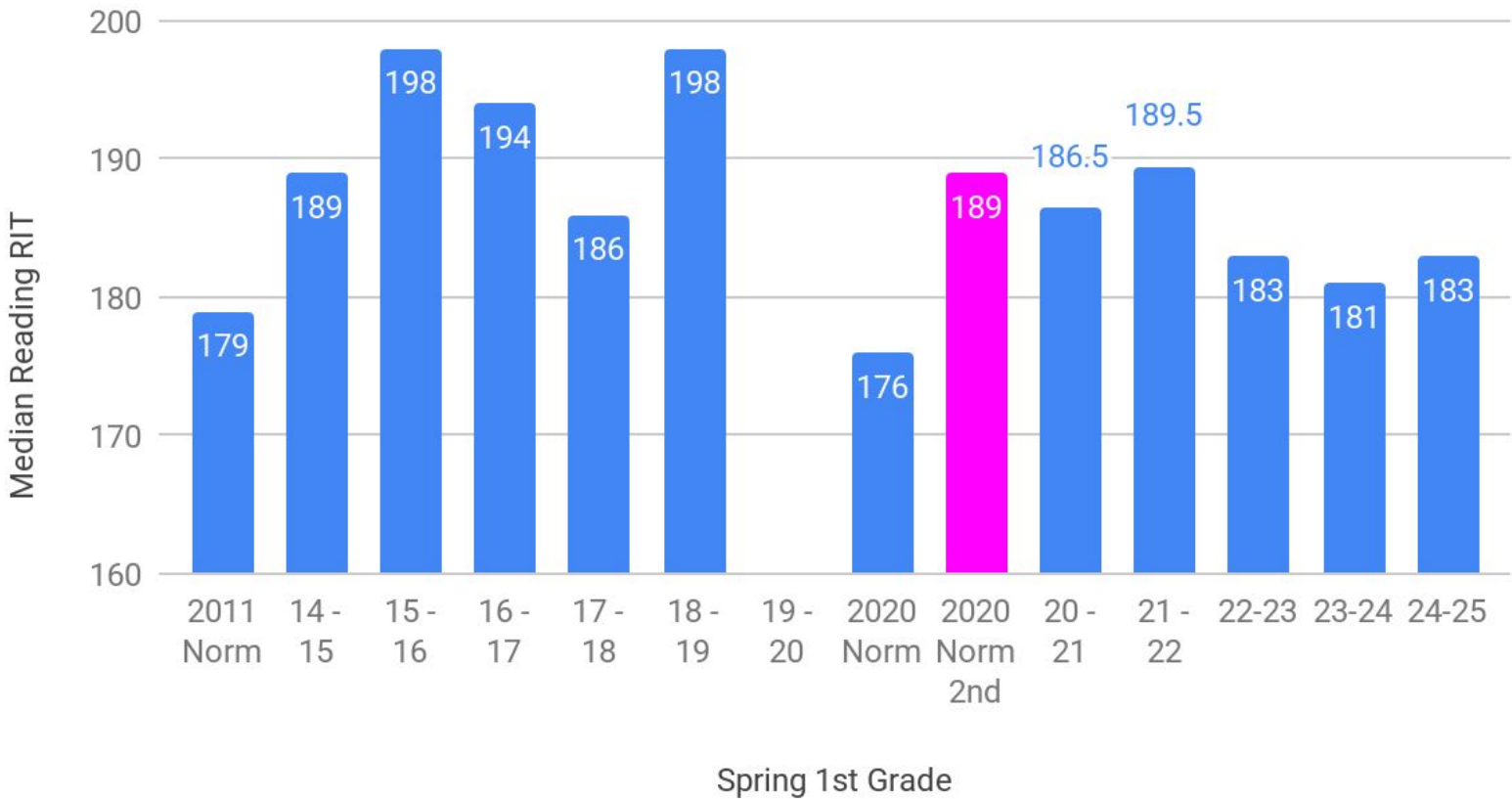

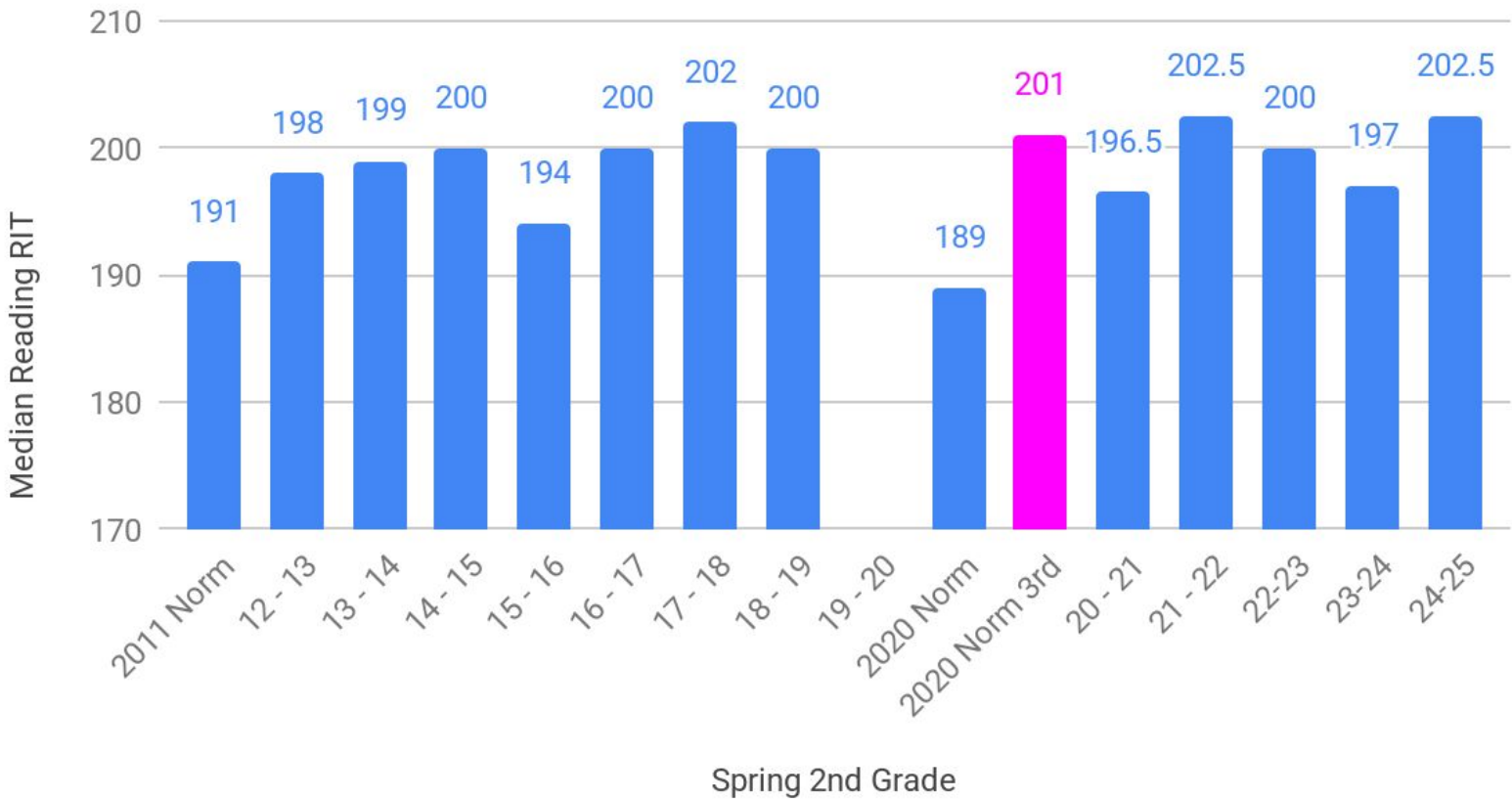
Median Math RIT vs. Spring Kindergarten



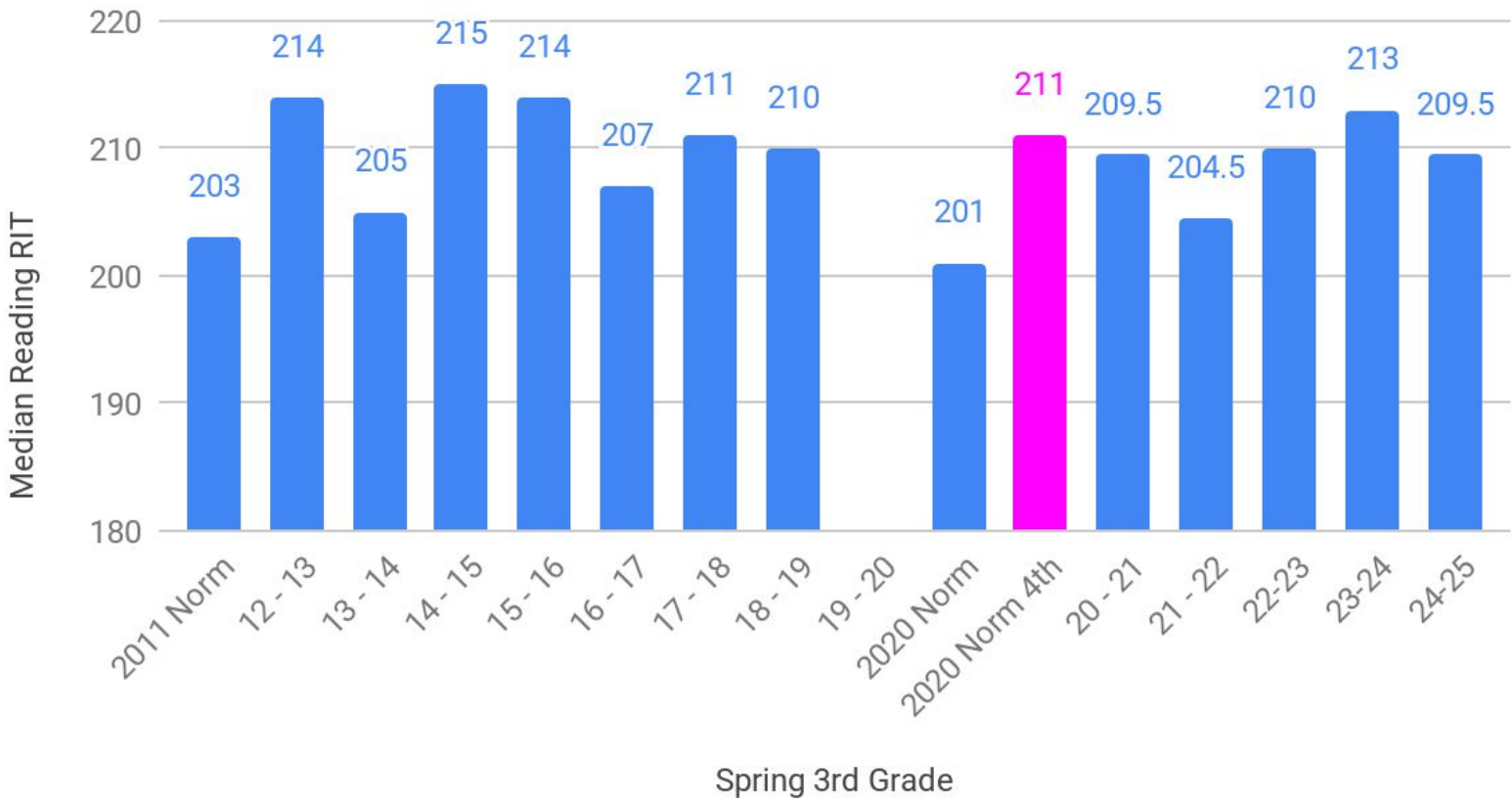
Median Math RIT vs. Spring 1st Grade



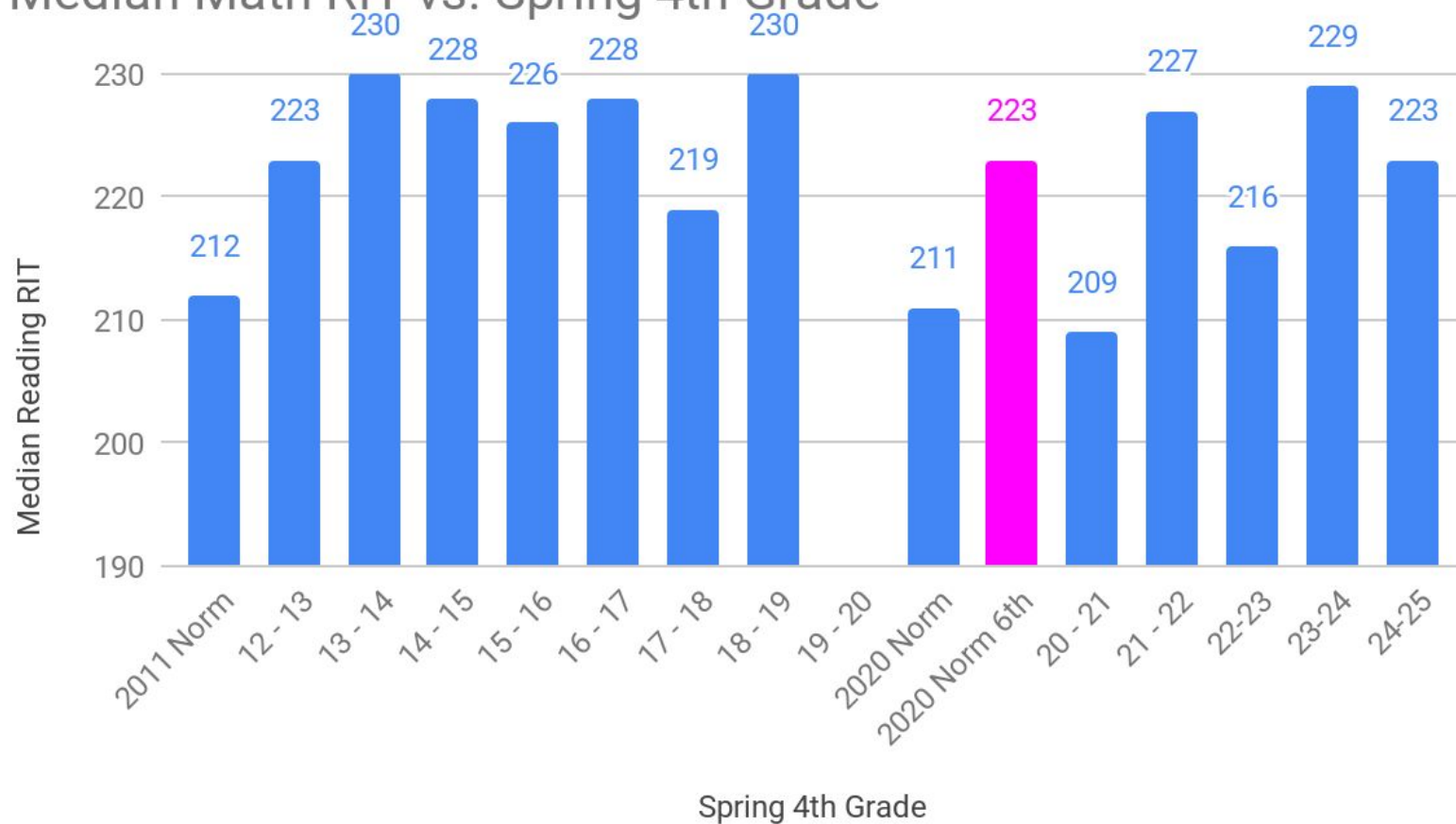
Median Math RIT vs. Spring 2nd Grade



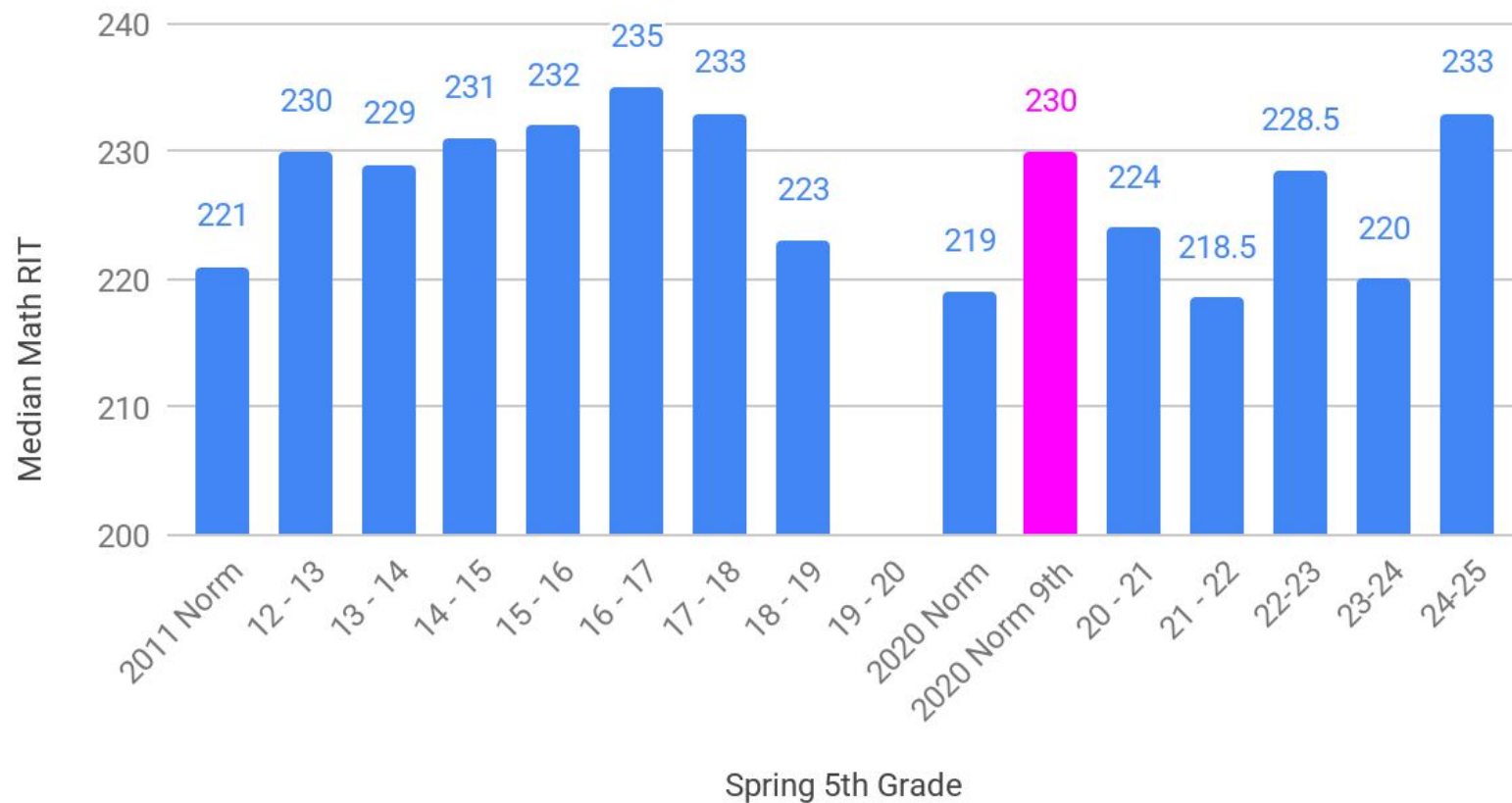

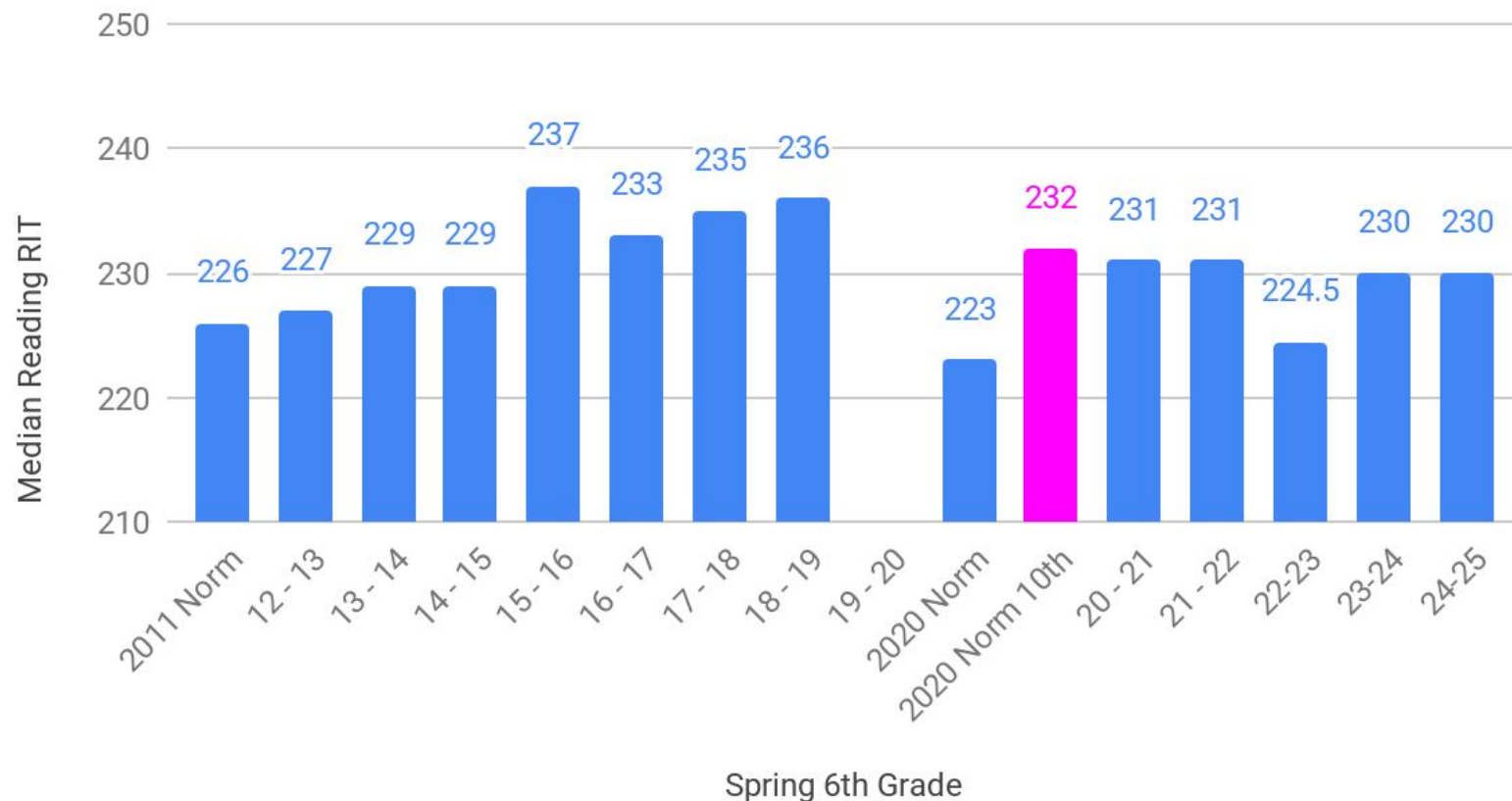

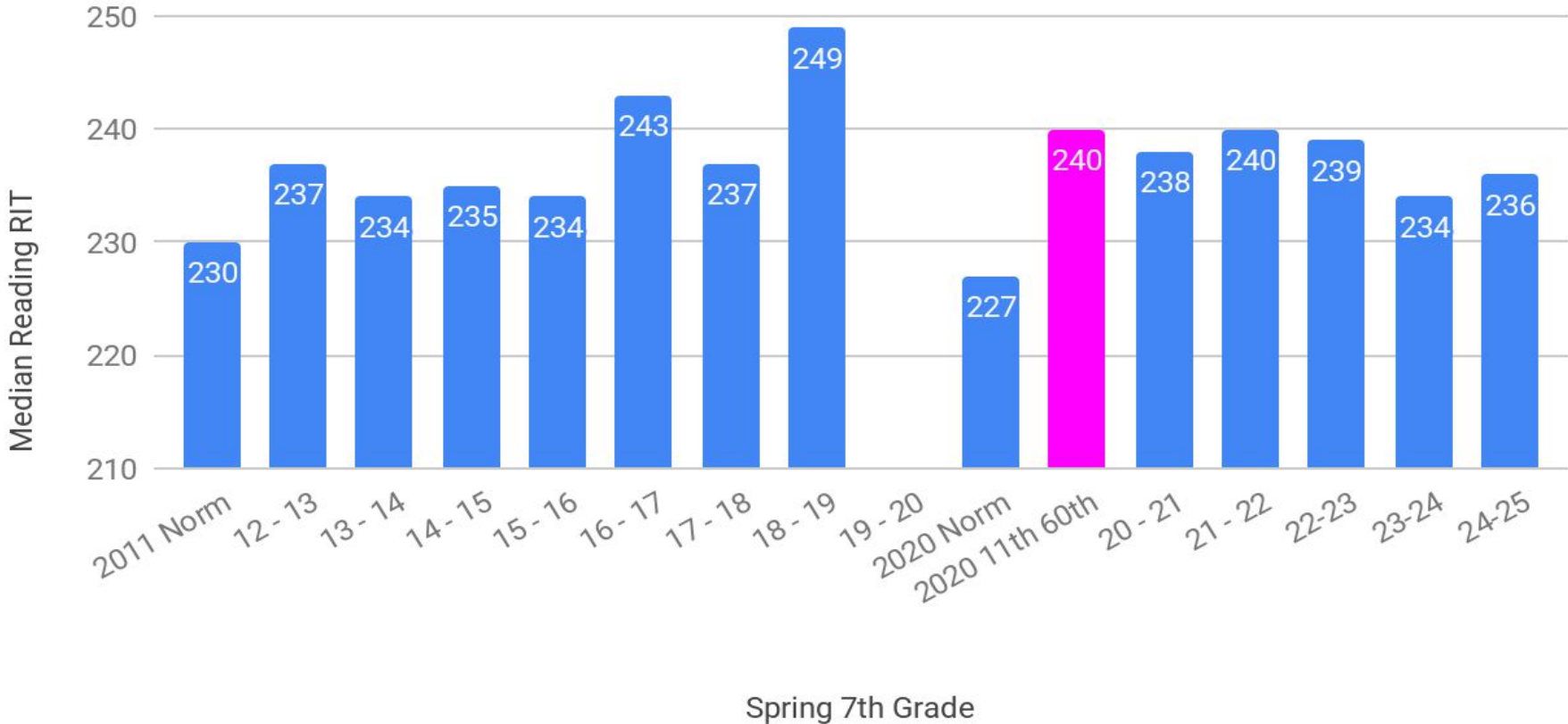

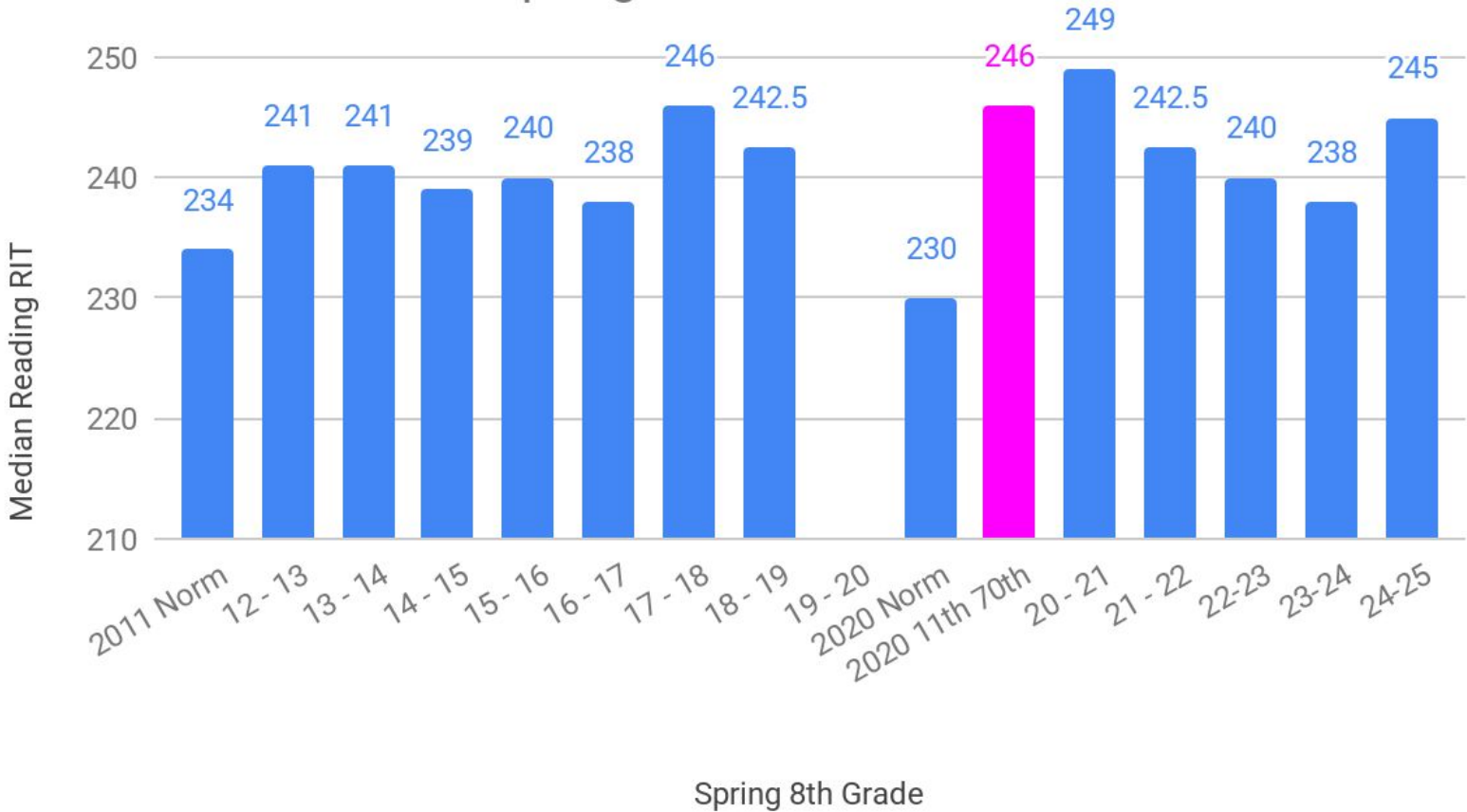

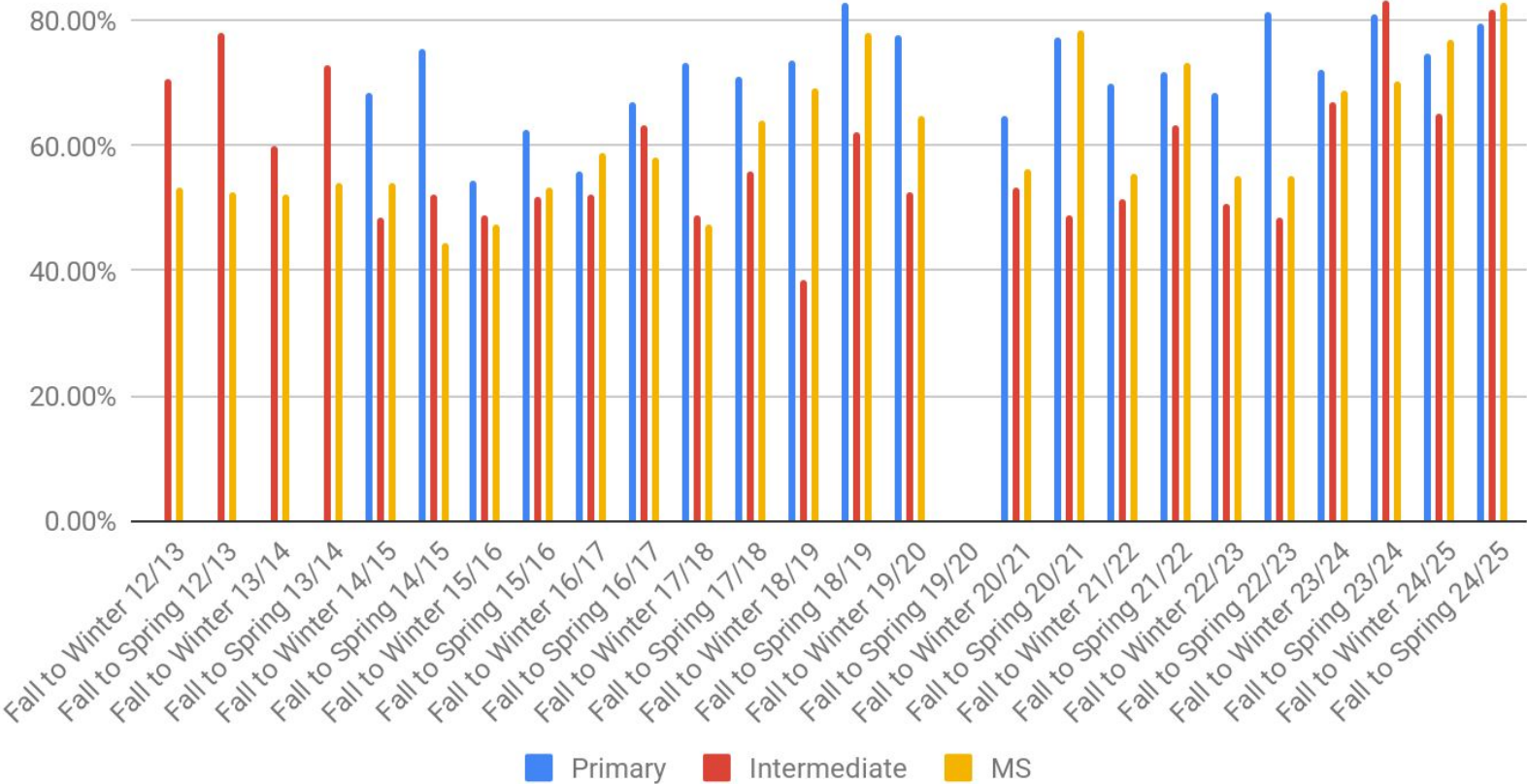

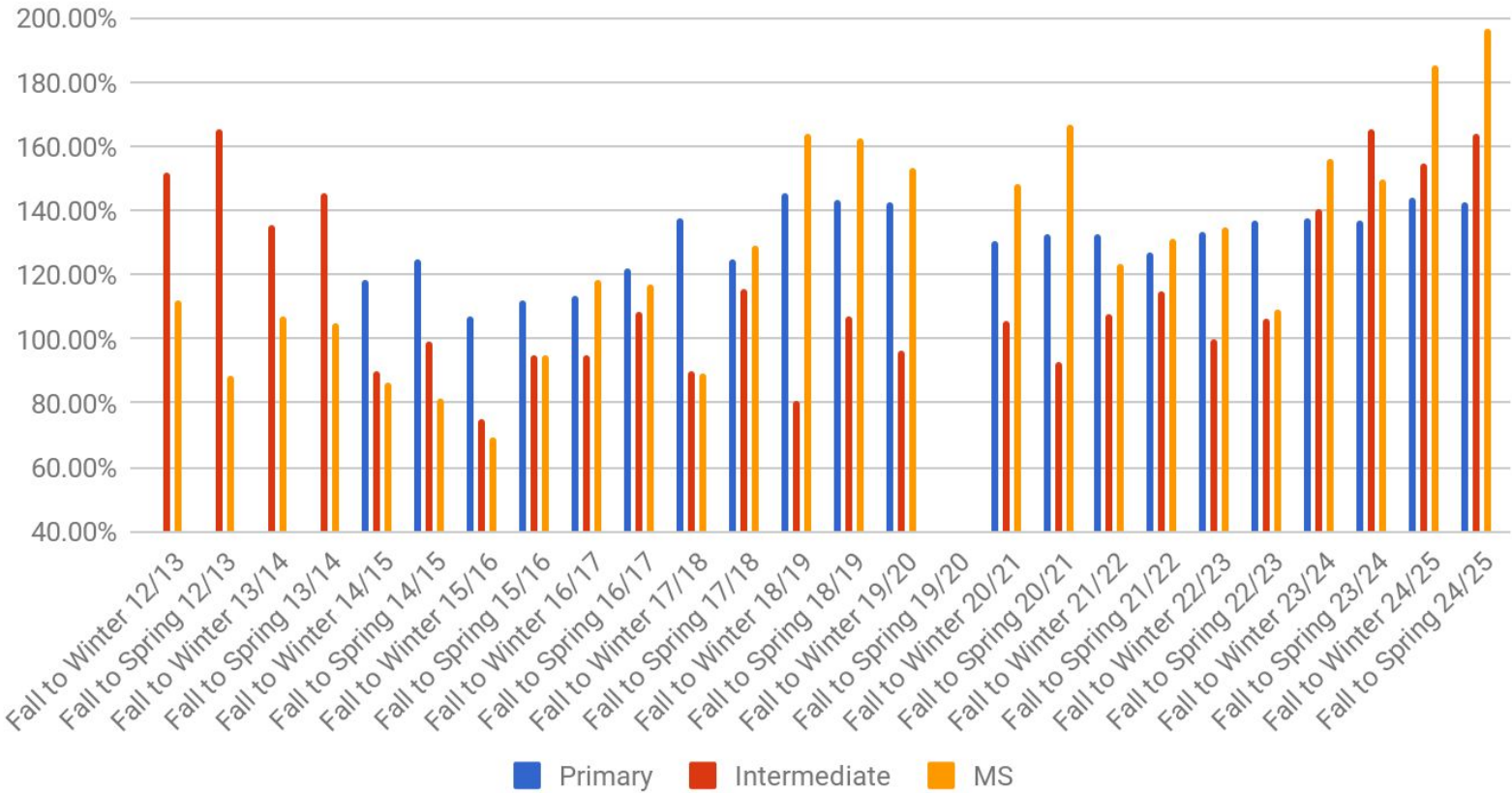

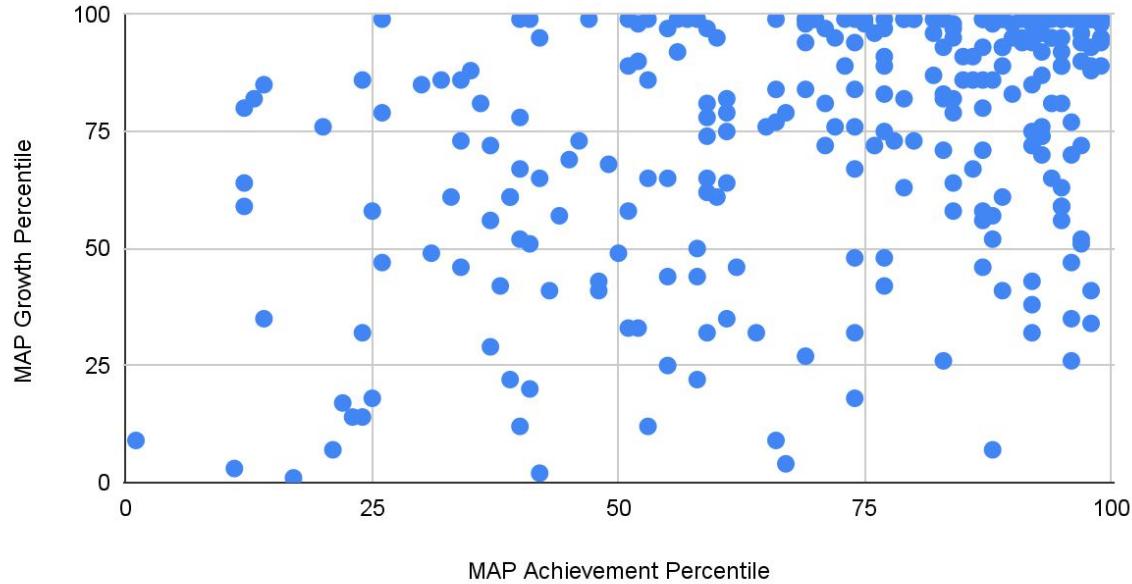
Math - % of Students Meeting & Exceeding MAP Growth Targets



Math - % of Growth Compared to Projected MAP Growth Targets



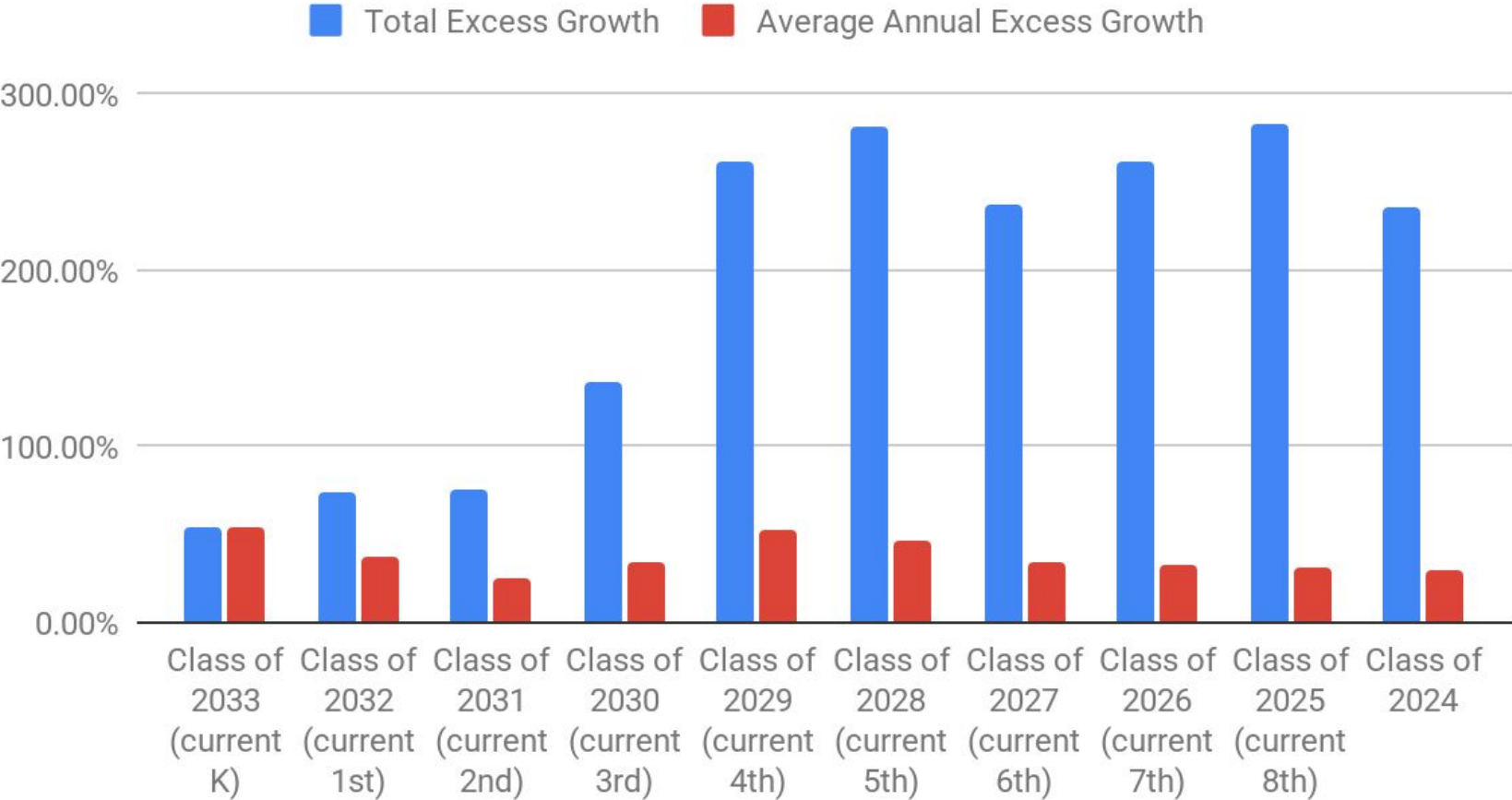

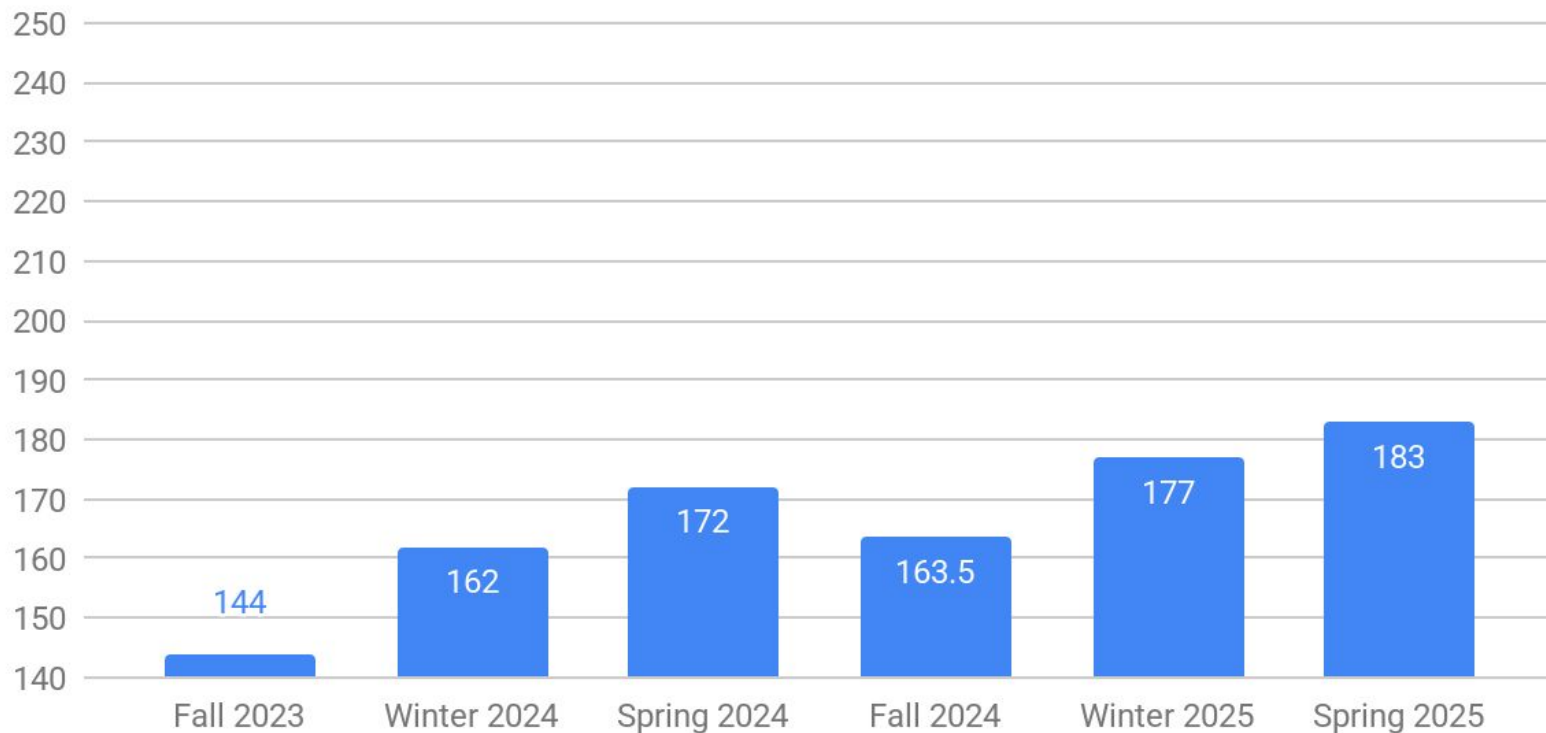

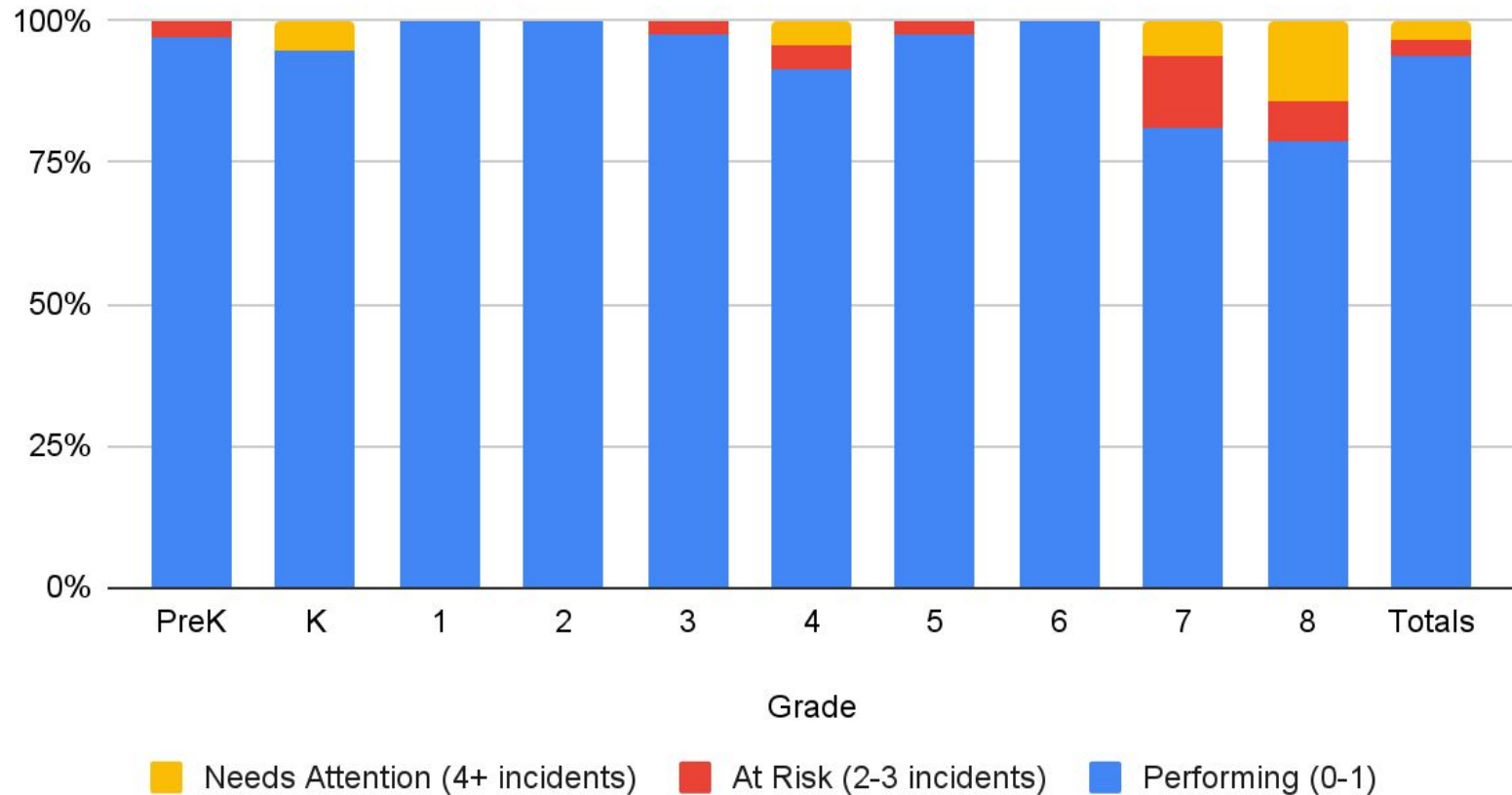
