Re: 2011-2012 Breakfast Program

We would like to discuss the school district's breakfast program at the October 24, 2011 Finance Committee meeting. The State requires that we provide a breakfast program in schools with 20% or more free and reduced eligible students. Therefore we will provide breakfast at Cleveland, Coolidge, Cooper, Garfield, Grant, Hayes, Johnson, and Rosedale Elementary Schools; Emerson and Frost Middle Schools; Churchill, Franklin and Stevenson High Schools; Western Wayne Skill Center and the Northwest Trainable Center at Webster next year. Stevenson High School will offer a breakfast program because the staff is available to facilitate the program. These buildings are the same as last year. Attached please find a detailed memo from Kristen Hennessey, Food Service Supervisor indicating which schools will have a breakfast program next year.

In addition, part of the yearly process requires that the District opt out of a breakfast program in schools where we are not providing breakfast. A public hearing for this process is required and we will ask the Board of Education to schedule the public hearing at the next regular Board meeting (in a separate meeting scheduled prior to the regular meeting).

SUBJECT: Breakfast Program

In accordance with the Breakfast Mandate Section 1272a (2) of the Michigan School Code, a building is mandated to serve breakfast if the total free and reduced applications equal 20% or more of the enrollment. The October 2010 Claim for Reimbursement is used to determine this mandate. Therefore the following buildings meet the mandate to serve breakfast this school year:

•	Coolidge	14%
•	Cooper	33%
•	Emerson	35%
•	Franklin	30%
•	Frost	23%
•	Garfield	49%
•	Grant	25%
•	Hayes	34%

Stevenson High School is 11% free and reduced and has served breakfast for several years as we have the staff to facilitate the program and the building principal determined a need.

These are the same schools that had the breakfast program in 2010-11.
