ALIGNS TO BOARD PRIORITY:

• Safety – The District will maintain a safe and orderly environment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The following information is being presented in order to keep the Board informed of AISD safety practices and resources.

- Education Code 37.108 requires school districts to adopt a multi-hazard Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) for use in the district's facilities. The plan must address mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery as defined by the commissioner of education in conjunction with the governor's office of homeland security.
- Districts are required to train employees how to respond to an emergency situation through mandatory drills. Districts are also responsible for taking measures to ensure coordination with local emergency management agencies, law enforcement, and fire departments in the event of an emergency.
- Districts must implement a security audit of all the district's facilities at least once every three years. Aledo ISD will be conducting the state mandate security audit during the 2013-2014 school year.
