DESCRIPTION:

Beginning with the 2026–2027 school year, Minnesota law requires all school districts to develop and annually review a Cardiac Emergency Response Plan (CERP) to establish procedures for responding to sudden cardiac arrest on school property and at school-sponsored activities. The proposed plan has been developed in alignment with the statute and outlines district protocols for emergency response, AED placement and maintenance, team activation, annual drills, and ongoing evaluation of the plan's effectiveness. This plan has been developed in collaboration with the Institute for Environmental Assessment (IEA).

The proposed Cardiac Emergency Response Plan will be presented to the School Board for review and discussion. Board action is not requested at this meeting.
