# **Madison School Improvement Plan 2025-2026**

### **Madison SMART Goal 1:**

In order to improve student learning in ELA, by the end of the 2025-2026 school year, 70% of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be at or above the 70<sup>th</sup> percentile as evidenced by the district benchmark ELA assessments.

**Action Item A:** Teachers will analyze standards-based grading data to inform classroom instruction as evidenced by student assessment data.

**Action Item B:** Teachers will analyze standards-based grading data to inform targeted interventions as evidenced by student assessment data.

**Action Item C:** Teachers will develop an Amplify walk-through tool.

**Action Item D:** Administration will conduct monthly walk throughs to monitor ongoing implementation of Amplify.

**Action Item E:** Teachers will utilize student-centered engagement strategies and small group instruction as evidenced by walkthrough data.

**Action Item F:** Teachers will analyze and use assessment data to provide targeted, research-based interventions to all students as evidenced by walkthrough data.

**Action Item G:** Teachers will reteach and reassess skill deficits during WIN time as evidenced by progress monitoring data.

### **Madison SMART Goal #2:**

In order to improve student learning in Math, by the end of the 2025-2026 school year, 70% of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be at or above the 70<sup>th</sup> percentile as evidenced by the STAR Math assessment.

**Action Item A:** Teachers will analyze standards-based grading data to inform classroom instruction as evidenced by student assessment data.

**Action Item B:** Teachers will analyze standards-based grading data to inform targeted interventions as evidenced by student assessment data.

**Action Item C:** Administration will conduct monthly walk throughs to monitor ongoing implementation of Envision.

**Action Item D:** Teachers will utilize student-centered engagement strategies and small group instruction as evidenced by walkthrough data.

**Action Item E:** Teachers will analyze and use assessment data to provide targeted, research-based interventions to all students as evidenced by walkthrough data.

**Action Item F:** Teachers will reteach and reassess skill deficits during WIN time as evidenced by progress monitoring data.

### **Madison SMART Goal #3:**

In order to increase student achievement and engagement, we will decrease the rate of chronic absenteeism to 10% for all students and 10% for students with disabilities.

#### **Action Item A:**

A task force will monitor attendance data and put attendance incentives in place for classes and individuals.

#### **Action Item B:**

Madison Staff will plan quarterly events to increase parent involvement at school with a focus on the importance of attendance.

**Action Item C:** Madison Staff will create a survey for students to evaluate student connectedness and engagement with school.

**Action Item D:** Case managers will schedule an IEP/504 team meeting and draft attendance goals once per quarter for any student below 90% attendance with parents and the school team.

#### **Action Item E:**

Madison staff will send home quarterly attendance reports and attendance flyers to parents and provide student incentives for parent signatures.

## **Madison SMART Goal: #4**

By the end of the school year 2026, staff will implement a framework for MTSS Behavior, utilizing discipline, and SAEBRS data to drive tiered social emotional services for all students and reduce office discipline referrals by 10%.

**Action Item A:** Staff will hold monthly MTSS days for problem solving meetings on students in the top 10% of behavior referrals as evidenced by problem solving meeting notes.

**Action Item B:** Staff will create and implement a system for student accountability and reflection after a major referral.

**Action Item C:** All staff will participate in Conscious Discipline training related to classroom management and addressing difficult behaviors in the classroom.
