# Workers' Compensation Administrative Services Program and Excess Coverage

May 24, 2016

#### **SUMMARY:**

This item requests renewal of the Workers' Compensation Administrative Services Program and Excess Workers' Compensation Coverage.

### **BOARD GOAL:**

VI. Growth, Change and Fiscal Responsibility...demonstrate effective and efficient management of District resources.

## PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board approved the recommendation of the Texas Association of School Boards for Administrative Services Only for the Workers' Compensation Fund on December 12, 2006. This inter-local agreement is renewed annually.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On May 27, 2015, the District opted to continue with TASB Risk Fund for Workers' Compensation – Administrative Services Only Program and Safety National Casualty Corporation for Excess Workers' Compensation Coverage. The Excess Workers' Compensation coverage had a \$500,000 specific self-insured retention, \$1,000,000 aggregate retention and \$1,000,000 aggregate excess limit with a premium of \$76,760. The Administrative Services Only Program included Annual Actuarial Review Services and Loss Prevention Services for a premium of \$12,000.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

For 2016-2017, the Fund has proposed Excess Workers' Compensation Coverage with a premium of \$81,147. This includes a \$500,000 specific self-insured retention, \$1,000,000 aggregate retention and \$1,000,000 aggregate excess limit. The annual premium for the Administrative Services Only Program with options for the Annual Actuarial Review and Loss Prevention Services will remain at \$12,000. Claims Administration Fees will increase as follows:

Record Claim only	\$ 20 per claim	\$ 20 per claim

The law allows us to stop benefits for actual holiday breaks. Only those employees who were normally scheduled to work during these times will receive benefits.

# SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend that the District continue Safety National Casualty Corporation Excess Workers' Compensation Coverage with a \$500,000 specific self-insured retention, \$1,000,000 aggregate retention and \$1,000,000 aggregate excess limit with a premium of \$81,147 for a period of July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017. Additionally, it is recommended that the District continue with TASB Risk Fund for Workers' Compensation – Administrative Services Only with optional services for Annual Actuarial Review and Loss Prevention Services. The annual premium for these services will total \$12,000. The combined total annual premium is \$93,147.00 which is an increase of \$4,387.00.
