SB 546 Three-Point Seat Belt Study

Background Information

SB 546 legislation requires public school districts to present retrofit and replacement requirements for all school buses in the district fleet publicly. Weatherford ISD is required to submit an electronic report of all school bus assets and three-point seat belt information thru Sentinel upon completion. An assessment of the current fleet, in accordance with the SB 546 requirements, was conducted and the results include the retrofitting of 44 school buses and the replacement of 23 school buses prior to September 2029.

Weatherford ISD has been awarded a Texas Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Program (TxVEMP) Grant to support the replacement of 3 existing diesel school buses with 3 new electric school buses. Weatherford ISD is pending another TxVEMP Grant for 5 additional EV buses. Weatherford ISD has applied for a TCEQ Clean Bus Grant for 3 diesel school buses being purchased in 2026. There are 6 additional buses that can be submitted for grants prior to September 2029.

There are additional school buses that are anticipated to reach their service life prior to September 2029. TEA has not release retrofitting requirements and restrictions. This information will be released after the study is complete in Summer 2026.
