From these 7 candidates, 5 were invited to an in person interview. The interview team consisted of Lynn McKinney, Denise Dugger, and Kathy Allen. From these interviews an approved AP Pool was developed and forwarded to Julie Choate. There were 4 candidates in the approved AP pool, 2 internal and 2 external. Ms. Choate interviewed all 4 of these finalists before deciding on and making the offer to Rebecca Faulkner.
