The Board of Trustees of Minidoka County Joint School District No. 331 shall appoint a committee of community members which will function as the district Safety and Drug-Free Advisory_Ceommittee. Consideration should be given to ethnographic representation of the community and the committee make up should reflect appropriate ethnic representation appointments.

Provisions:

The following provisions will be used for implementation.

- 1. The board shall appoint no fewer than ten individuals to serve on the committee.
- 2. The membership of the committee will perform its duties under the provisions of the state Safe and Drug Free Handbook, and the recommendations and advice of the <u>state and district Substance AbuseSafety</u> and Drug-Free FacilitatorCoordinator.
- The meetings will be held at least every other month or at the discretion and/or the recommendation of the <u>Safety Drug Free Facilitator Coordinator</u> and committee members.
- 4. The committee will review the district <u>substance abuse/and building</u> safe & drug-free programs for effectiveness utilizing the Principals of Effectiveness and recommend changes.
- 5. The Safety & Drug-Free ty Advisory Committee will submit the district program recommendations to the school board on an annual basis.
