BACKGROUND/CONSIDERATIONS:

On January 26, 2026, the FSPS Board voted to right size both Carnall and Spradling Elementary. The Long Range Facilities Planning (LRFP) Committee met on February 26th and April 2nd, 2026 to consider plans for addressing aging facilities and repurposing the Carnall and Spradling properties. All departments impacted shared a joint presentation for the LRFP Committee's consideration. The recommendations of the LRFP Committee will be shared in this presentation requesting Board approval.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The LRFP Committee and Administration recommends that the Board approve to

- Close the Parker Center Building and relocate administrative services currently housed there to Carnall.
- Close the Rogers Center Building and relocate administrative services currently housed there to Carnall and the Service Center
- Close the Peabody Building and relocate Adult Ed services currently housed there to Spradling.
