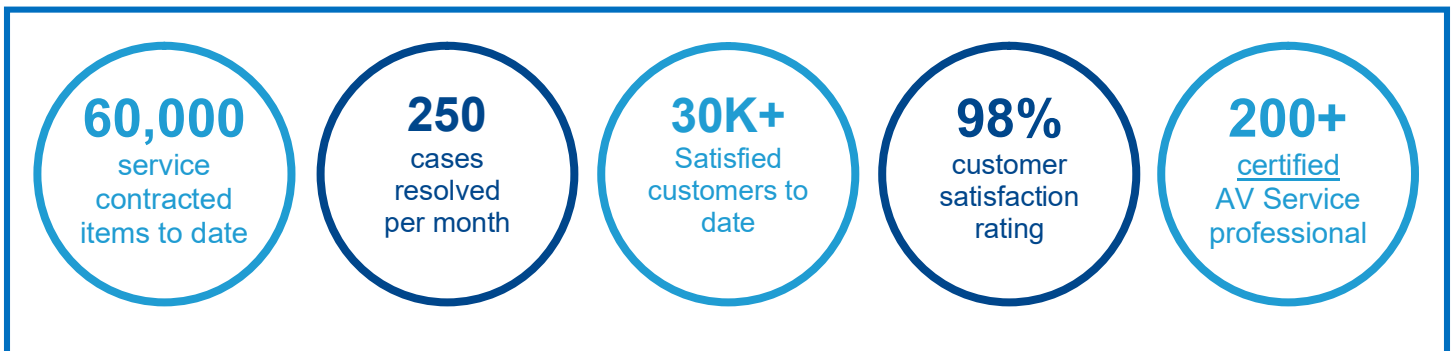

Drawing submittals will be provided using AutoCAD, on disc or pre-plotted. AV drawings will match an existing architectural, AutoCAD or drawing title block format already in use. These requirements need to be provided to us before drafting begins. All fees quoted for this project include one drawing package revision. Client requested revisions above this will be treated as a change order.

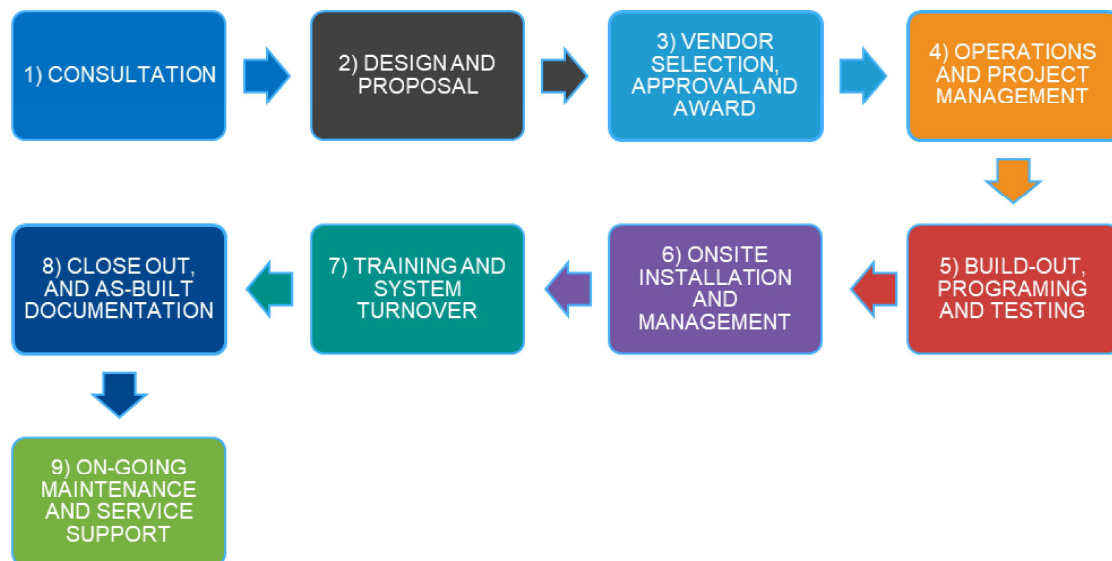
PROCESS

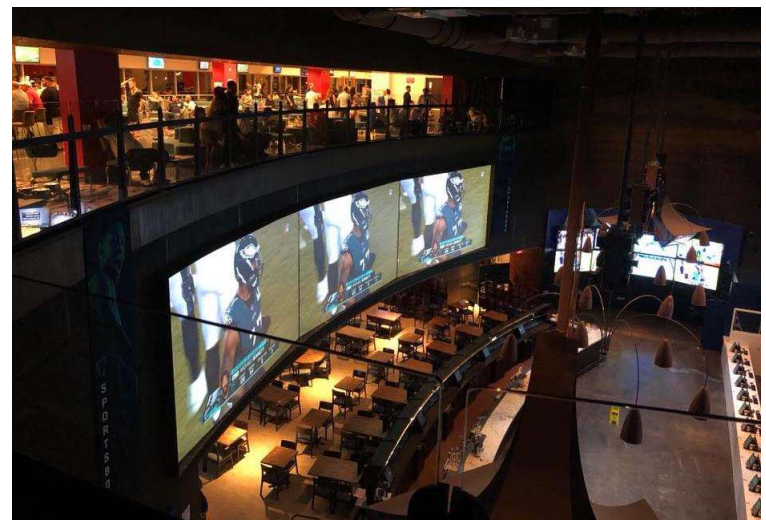

North Slope Borough School District has asked Solutionz, Inc. to provide a proposal for AV systems in their Barrow High School Auditorium, Eben Hopson Middle School Multipurpose Room, Wainwright Alak School Gym, and Point Hope Tikigaq School Gym. Solutionz, Inc. has reviewed the user requirements and proposes the following AV systems.

This proposal is valid for fourteen (14) days from date of delivery of Statement of Work. This proposal includes installation of Solutionz, Inc.'s specified equipment and Owner Furnished Equipment (OFE). Solutionz, Inc. will provide equipment identified in the estimates, post-sale engineering support, project management, installation, testing, and orientation of the system once installed.

Solutionz, Inc. assumes all required items not in our scope of work will be completed by the owner, or owner supplied contractor, and in the specified time frame. Any delay, or changes, could increase the time frame to complete the project, and increase the installation cost.

The Zoom Room touch panel will be in the control room. A PTZ camera will be mounted on either side of the stage. The third PTZ camera will be mounted at the back of the house. The dedicated compute device and touch panel will be configured to native Zoom Room mode. The native Zoom Room graphic user interface (GUI) provides a simple and familiar platform with features such as one-touch join, content sharing, camera options, and meeting management.

An Extron SMP 351 live streaming device will be provided for steaming of content to YouTube, Facebook, Twitch, or any other streaming platform. The live streaming device has an HDMI input for user content and one for a camera feed. It will allow users to show just the content, show just the camera feed, or show the content and provide a picture in picture of a camera feed.

The audio system will feature fifteen wireless conference units with gooseneck microphones, four wireless handheld microphones, two surface mounted speakers, and any other speakers we can get to function. The wireless conference units will be used for meetings on the stage and will not be used for sound reinforcement. The surface mount speakers will provide audio reinforcement for virtual meetings, program audio, and voice lift of the wireless microphones. The audio will be mixed, processed, and routed using a Biamp audio digital signal processor (DSP).

Users will have four options to present content to a virtual meeting, streaming platform, and/or the room video destinations.
