It has been a good spring for Homedale athletics. Excited for all of the district tournament action to start this coming Saturday, May 8th.

Baseball-

Varsity finished regular season play as the number 2 seed in the conference, which is a big deal since our district tournaments have moved to a higher seed host format. Their first district game will be on Monday, May 10th. Not sure yet who we will play, most likely Weiser. If we qualify for the state tournament, it will be hosted at Fruitland High School May 20-22.

JV Baseball finished tied for 2nd seed in their conference. However, there weren't enough JV teams to end the year to have a district tournament, so their season is officially over.

Softball-

Varsity finished as the number 1 overall seed in conference play. Like baseball, higher seed hosts, so we will get to host any and all games we play in during the district tournament. If the softball team qualifies for the state tournament, it will be hosted at Timberline High School in Boise, May 21-22.

JV finished as the number 1 overall seed in conference play. Like JV baseball there aren't enough teams to have a district tournament.

Track-

Track is having a great year with multiple kids setting PR's at almost every event. Thomas Symms broke JB Salutregui's discus record two weeks ago, throwing a distance of 169-4. There are a couple other school records that could be broken as well before it is all said and done. Track's district meet will be in Parma, May 14-15.

Golf-

Golf just finished their regular season schedule. The boys team finished 4th overall. We are hosting the district tournament on May 11th. Hopefully we have a couple kids shoot their best and are able to sneak us into a state qualifying spot, which means we have to finish in the top two spots.

Tea Uranga continues to dominate on the girls' side of things individually. She is the clear favorite to win the district tournament.

State golf will be held in Rathdrum, ID at Twin Lakes Golf Course, May 17-18.

For JV golf they might try and have a district tournament on Monday, May 10th at Scotch Pines. It would be a 9 hole event only.

Tennis-
