
January 2026 Board Report

Testing Schedule

As December winds down, Napi staff are gearing up for the upcoming assessments in January and early February.

Aimsweb– January 20-23 - all students

Writing Assessment– February 2-6 - all students with 4th grade completing Blue Book writing and 5th grade completing My Access writing.

MAST Assessments– Beginning mid to late January, the 4th grade students are preparing for the following MAST assessments: Reading Informational and Literary MAST, and in Math, the following standards assessments-

- Extend Concepts of Multiplication
- Multi-digit Multiplication
- Multi-digit Division
- Real World Problems and Patterns

The 5th grade began preparing for the following MAST assessments: Reading Informational and Literary MAST, and in Math, the following standards assessments-

- Add and Subtract Fractions
- Multiply Fractions
- Division with Fractions

MAST preparations will continue throughout the second testing window, which closes on March 6, 2026.

WIDA– Beginning in January, the window opens for the annual English Language Learner testing. Napi will begin assessing 4th and 5th grade students identified as EL learners the week of January 12. Students will be assessed in the four domains of the English language-

- Reading
- Speaking
- Listening
- Writing
