We are having Saturday School, all 3 Saturdays in December, for students who have missed more than 8 days this semester.


We had 4 cell phones picked up: \$150 towards our scholarship fund.

It's important for everyone to know they are loved. We love the students and staff of QISD and want to remind them of that when they walk through the doors at QHS!




## STAAR EOC Retests were given December 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>
