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Focus for 2015-2016

- Implement "STEM Thursdays"
 - Develop STEM lessons through the use of EIE (Engineering is Elementary) Kits
- Build trust and positive relationships
 - Students, teachers, families, community





Public Schools

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Reading Seed Kinder Program

- Through a Partnership with Literacy Connects...
 - Volunteers commit to coaching kindergarten students for one hour twice a week
 - Reading
 - Literacy Games
 - Replicates the "lap experience"
 - Students receive a brand new free book after every tutoring session
 - "On average, students in kindergarten who were enrolled in Reading Seed showed 70% greater gains in assessed literacy skills than students who did not participate in the program." –Literacy Connects
