Basic Information:

This is a request for the Board of Education to approve a contract between District 33 and Dr. Pete Marcelo, an independent contractor who will be serving in the role of a school psychologist for the 2025-2026 school year.

Background/Historical Context:

School Psychologists continue to be one of the most challenging positions to fill. It is challenging for school districts to hire staff for this position, and most agencies do not have available school psychologists to do contracted work. Currently, District 33 has a school psychologist vacancy at preschool and Dr. Pete Marcelo, a qualified school psychologist, has offered to perform school psychologist services as an independent contractor.
