Information

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Texas Education Agency has invited districts to express their interest in participating in a pilot program for the local accountability systems (LAS) established by House Bill 22 (85th Texas Legislature, 2017). The purpose is to allow campuses to be rated using locally developed domains and accountability measures.

Requirements for Districts

- Include the TEA-assigned three domain performance ratings (at least 50% of the overall rating).
- Locally developed domain and measures must provide for the assignment of A–F grades, and be reliable and valid.

More Requirements for Districts

- Calculations must be auditable
- Campus score card that may be displayed on TEA’s website
- Publicly available explanation of the methodology used to assign ratings
- Plans submitted to TEA for approval

The LAS Pilot Time Line

Phase 1: Districts submit Notification of Interest Form. Deadline is October 31, 2017.

Phase 2: Texas Education Agency reviews Notice of Interest forms, selects pilot participants, and provides detailed explanation of participation in, and commitment to, the LAS pilot to selected districts. Deadline is December 1, 2017.

Phase 3: Districts/campuses will create Pilot Plans and present to School Boards for approval. After approval, proposals will be submitted to TEA. School System Deadline - January 19, 2018.

Phase 4: Pilot program results released in conjunction with 2018 accountability ratings. Deadline is August 15, 2018.
