District plan to make up time or days for inclement weather

In a recent Commissioner's Memo released by the Arkansas Department of Education the state provided guidance regarding options for Districts to make up instructional time missed due to inclement weather. Districts currently on a traditional 178-day calendar may request to change to an alternate calendar, which requires 1,068 hours, the equivalent of 6 hours of instructional time for 178 days (6 hours per day x 178 days = 1068 hours of instruction).

It is important to note that 6 hours of instruction time each day is a minimum standard. Currently all K-12 schools across the Paragould School District provide a minimum of 6 hours and 15 minutes of instruction in the daily schedule. By switching from a traditional calendar to an alternate calendar the Paragould School District will be able to bank up to 7 days of instructional time (15 minutes per day x 174 days = 2610 minutes). A total of 2610 minutes / 360 minutes per day = just over 7 days. Our preschool program is open from 7.45 - 3.00 each day. This is also 15 minutes more than the 7 hours that are required in the ADE Rules Governing Arkansas Better Chance. Our intention is to provide a plan that parallels K-12 schools across the District.

As a result of inclement weather/road conditions the District was closed on January 15-18 (4 days). If the District transitions to an alternate calendar students will NOT be required to make up bad weather days as a result of banked instructional time. We have the ability to miss 3 additional days without having to add make up days to the end of the school calendar. The last day of the year remains May 24, 2024.

- 3. Dr. Jankoviak passed out a handout on inclement weather make-up day guidance from the Arkansas Department of Education Commissioner's Memo on January 25, 2024.
 - a. https://adecm.ade.arkansas.gov/ViewApprovedMemo.aspx?ld=5567
 - b. Options for our district:
 - i. We can add time and days to our traditional calendar.
 - This means attending school 4 days of our make-up days scheduled on the calendar.
 - ii. Or, we switch to an alternate calendar where we go by hours instead of days
 - 1. We are already above the standard amount of daily time required so we can use the time we have banked to count towards our missed time.
 - 2. Standard amount of daily time is 360 minutes. We currently go 375 minutes.
 - a. 15 minutes X 174 days= 2610 minutes or 7.25 days
 - 3. With this amount of time banked, we would not have to make up any days.
 - c. The PPC committee voted to switch the Paragould School District Calendar to the alternate calendar of 1068 hours instead of the traditional calendar that we currently have of 178 days.
 - All in favor of adopting the alternate calendar for the remainder of the 2024 year-9, All opposed-0.
 - d. Questions were asked about the pre-K because their grant requires them to go 178 days regardless.
 - Video was played from Arkansas Deputy Commissioner, Stacy Smith that gave some insight that the 178 were being looked into for pre-K.
 - e. Video also mentioned that schools could still do a 178 day calendar and have those days banked for inclement weather because 1068 hours is the minimum required not the maximum and it gives the schools ability for flexibility.
 - f. DESE wants schools to continue to go the 178 days even when switching to the alternate so that the days are banked and the schools do not have to worry about make-up days for inclement weather.
