10 Helpful Hints for Parents to Help your Child Succeed

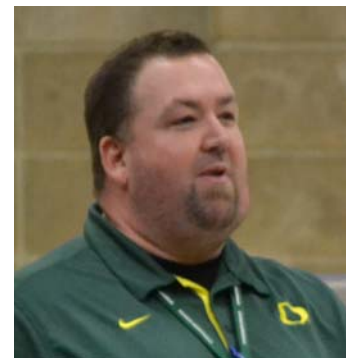
1. Get involved at school...

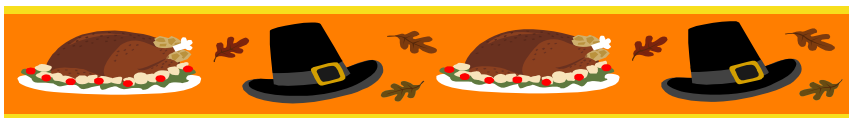
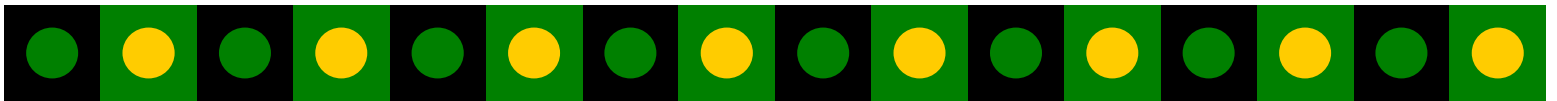
