Information to keep in mind while answering question 2:

Physical security changes have been made to the building. Some of the security enhancements include:

- Check in area for parents/visitors prior to getting into the school
- Locked doors at both entrances except during student bus arrival and dismissal
- Security cameras in hallways and entrances, viewable inside the school and by police.
- Improvements in the outside walls of the building, including bullet resistant glass.

The financial cost of various security personnel are listed below, as well as the staff reductions required to fund that cost. Given budget considerations for the district and state for FY19, any security personnel cost would have to be offset by staff reductions.

- SRO: Cost \$125,000 annually. Equivalent to a reduction of 2 teaching positions.
- Retired police officer Cost estimate \$60,000 annually. Equivalent to a reduction of 1 teaching position.
- Security Guard: Cost \$40,000 annually. Equivalent to ½ to ¾ teaching position.

Retired Police Officer: An armed retired police officer who is hired by the school District. Prior police employment, but no current police training or knowledge of current town police issues.

Security Guard: An unarmed security guard hired by the school District. Various levels of certification exist for this position.
