Agenda Item: Consider and take action regarding approving an amendment to the current JISD District of Innovation Plan seeking an exemption from TEC 21.401 Minimum Service Required.

CONSENT ITEM

RECOMMENDATION:

Judson ISD adminstration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the amendment to the Judson ISD District of Innovation Plan that seeks an exemption from TEC 21.401 Minimum Service Required which states an educator employed under a 10-month contract must provide a minimum of 187 days of service.

IMPACT/RATIONALE:

House Bill 1842, permits LEAs to become Districts of Innovation and to obtain exemptions from certain provisions of the Texas Education Code. TEC 21.401 Minimum Service Required states an educator employed under a 10-month contract must provide a minimum of 187 days of service. As required in the DOI Amendment process, the DSBC/DOI Committee met on May 29, 2025 and a majority vote of the District-level committee approved the recommendation to amend the Judson ISD DOI Plan to exempt the District from TEC 21.401 minimum service required. This means that Teachers, Librarians, Counselors and Nurses may work less than 187 days as approved by the Board of Trustees.
