## <u>Overview</u>

- The goal of LifeSmarts is to create consumer savvy young people who will be well equipped for adult life in today's complex, global marketplace. Entering its 27th year, Lifesmarts participants focus on five key topic areas: consumer rights and responsibilities, the environment, health and safety, personal finance, and technology. Tomahawk's 2021 team consisting of Allison Schmidt, Mya Dhaseleer, Catalina Dieter, Madilyn Baumann and Elizabeth Lee finished 3rd in the state, behind winner Belleville and runner up Oconto. Tomahawk will, however, be representing Wisconsin along with Belleville at this year's national championships April 17-19th having won the 2020 state competition and having the competition cancelled due to COVID-19.
- Brynnen Stefan has won a Silver Key in the 2021 Wisconsin Scholastic Art Awards. This is the most prestigious competition in the state.
