ALIGNS TO BOARD PRIORITY(S): CONTINOUS IMPROVEMENT- the District shall establish systems and processes to evaluate organizational effectiveness and customer satisfaction

Background Information:

- At the beginning of the 2012-13 school year, a set of 21 goals were established in alignment with the District's new three year 2012-2015 Strategic Plan.
- Our Strategic Plan contains six areas of priority and there were goals established for each of these areas:
 - Learning (3 goals)
 - Safety (4 goals)
 - Parents and Community (5 goals)
 - Human Resources (3 goals)
 - Financial and Facilities (3 goals)
 - Continuous Improvement (3 goals)
- In January, as part of the superintendent appraisal process, the Board reviewed the progress of these goals in relationship to the District Strategic Plan. At that time, 14 goals were completed.

Administrative Considerations:

- Based on the progress made to date, 20 of the 21 goals have been completed and the remaining goal will be completed once we have received our final test scores for the year.
