Reporters have the power to shape community attitudes about public schools, and the Media Honor Roll is a way for districts to recognize fair and balanced reporting about our schools.

The Media Honor roll recognizes representatives in print, radio, television, and online media who (1) make the effort to get to know the superintendent, board president, district's mission, and district's goals; (2) report school news in a manner that is fair, accurate, and balanced; (3) give a high-profile position to good news about schools; (4) visit the schools; and (5) maintain a policy of no surprises by sharing information with school representatives.

Submission Information

If you work with reporters who deserve recognition, your district can add their names to the honor roll. You can submit the names of radio or television stations, newspapers, online publications, or individual reporters. Find the nomination form and sample resolution at **tasb.org**: Place the cursor on the Services tab at top of the page and click on Communications + PR; select Recognition Programs from the left menu and then Media Honor Roll.
