I as well as others are strongly opposed to enforcing a mask 'required' mandate upon the students of the Harlem School district. I urge the School Board to make mask wearing optional. - 2) 'Maybe With Delta the CDC Will Learn to Count'²editorial describes the progress Britain has made and why their policies have loosened. The subtitle, 'In Britain, they know 92% of the public have antibodies; here we panic in the dark', describes our present confusion.
- 3) 'If Biden Is Serious about Covid, He'll Protect the Border'³highlights the immense lack of consistency in policy pronouncements. Is it any wonder that there is reasonable doubt and anger at this mask required mandate?

Furthermore:

- 4) We know that States mandating masks and those that did not over the past year had similar disease progression curves and per capita data.
