## Exhibit - Application and Procedures for Use of School Facilities

This application must be completed once per school year by all organizations or groups (including employees associated with a non-school related group) who are requesting use of school facilities and who are not school-affiliated organizations, school sponsored programs, or organizations whose primary purpose is to provide financial assistance to the school who are requesting use of school facilities (see Administrative Procedure 8.20-AP1 Community Use of School Facilities). A completed application must To-be submitted to and approved by the Building Administration of the requested school facility <u>prior to using school facilities</u>, along with <u>the applicable fee and either: (1)</u> a <u>certificate</u> of insurance naming Community Unit School District No. 5, McLean and Woodford Counties, Illinois as an additional insured; or (2) a completed Non-School Related Group Acknowledgment, Assumption of Risk, Release, and Indemnification form for each adult and minor participating in the organization or group using the school facility. This application must be approved before a non-school related group is allowed to use school facilities. Current full-time employees associated with a non-school related group may use school facilities for the group at no cost provided they are not charging a fee to participants and they are present and supervising use of the facilities when being used by the nonschool related group. School organizations, school sponsored programs, and organizations whose primary purpose is to provide financial assistance to the school are all considered, for the purpose of this application, to be school related. Use of school facilities for school purposes has precedence over all other uses.

By submitting this Application and in consideration for using school facilities, the Organization or Group agrees to:

- Follow all Board policies and school rules.
- All non school related groups must supply adequate supervision to ensure proper care and use of school facilities.
- The non school related group is responsible to the Board for the use and care of the school facility. Provide adequate adult supervision to ensure proper care and use of school facilities and that no minor is left alone after the activity. All adult supervisors must have cell phones with them at all times.

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• Sufficient, competent adult supervision must be provided and the adult supervisor must ensure that no minor is left alone after the activity.

- <u>Use only those school facilities and areas approved by the Building Administration.</u> Only the cafeteria, auditorium, gymnasium, and <u>designated</u> athletic fields, along with needed hallways and parking areas, are available for community use. <u>Pools are available for use with prior approval by Building Administration and limited to student groups, recognized community-based organizations, and governmental entities. A certificate of insurance with a minimum of \$1 million in liability coverage and naming the District as an additional insured must be provided and a certified lifeguard must be on duty at all times. Pool rentals by individuals are not permitted. Designated baseball or softball fields will be unlocked for use by the Building Administration and must be raked by the organization or group at the end of its use. Entering any room or area not in use by the group is prohibited. The adult supervisor will vacate the facility at the scheduled end time. Use of the school facility is not permitted past the agreed end time.</u>
- No<u>t move</u> furniture or equipment may be moved without prior approval from the Building Principal Administration.
- <u>Not attach, nail, or otherwise affix</u> <u>Ssigns, displays, or materials may not be attached, nailed, or otherwise affixed to walls.</u>
