This action offsets unobligated PA 4122 funds totaling \$31,318 from Program Year 30 to Program Year 32.

The HHS GPS (II-56) (see above) and Parts 74.25(c)(2) and 92.30(d)(3) (as applicable) provide the authority to ACF to approve Key Staff of Head Start Grantees. For the purposes of this grant, key staff is defined as the Head Start Director or person carrying out the duties of the Head Start Director if not under that title and the Chief Executive Officer, Executive Director and/or Chief Fiscal Officer if any of those positions is funded, either directly or through indirect cost recovery, more than 50% with Head Start funds.

No funds may be charged to the Head Start grant or to any other Federal program either as a direct cost or any pro-ration as an indirect cost for an employee whose compensation exceeds Executive Level II, which is currently \$179,700.

This action approves the reduction of 15 Head Start slots effective with the August 1, 2011 - July 31, 2012 budget period. The new funded enrollment level for the Head Start program is 255 children.
