TOPIC: APPROVE LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR CITY OF COLUMBUS TIF DISTRICT 1-1

**BACKGROUND:** The City of Columbus is proposing to provide tax increment financing to assist with economic development within their City. The TIF District is proposed to assist with the financing of a 100,000 square foot warehousing, storage, and distribution facility on a currently undeveloped "green acres" site within the City. The project is expected to commence in the fall of 2018 with completion in spring of 2019.

**PROCESS:** The Finance Committee has reviewed this item in detail and recommends that a letter of support for this project be transmitted to the City of Columbus.


This project will not impact any school district revenues.


The project will provide a larger tax base for the school district nine years from now when the Tax increment financing expires.
