BP 3542 Roles and Duties of **Bus and Vehicle Drivers Employees**

Authority of School Bus and Vehicle Drivers

Students transported in a school bus <u>or vehicle</u> shall be under the authority of, and responsible directly to, the driver of the bus<u>or vehicle</u>. The driver shall be held responsible for the orderly conduct of the students while they are on the bus, <u>in the vehicle</u>, or being escorted across a street, highway, or road.

(cf. 5131.1 - Bus Conduct)

All bus drivers shall receive training as mandated by law. <u>They Bus and vehicle drivers</u> who transport students also shall be familiar with and adhere to district policies and regulations relating to student transportation.

Note: State law, <u>AS 28.35.161</u>, prohibits texting while driving.

Bus and vehicle drivers are prohibited from utilizing a cell phone or other portable electronic device to read or type text messages or other non-voice communications while driving.
