March 18th Homedale Middle School 8th Graders visit the High School: The whole 8th grade class came to the high school on March 18th. They were paired up with upper classmen to help guide them through building a four year plan, participate in an extra-curricular fair in the old gym, take a tour through the high school and participate in a question and answer session with the upper class students. This visit will be followed up with a visit to the middle school on May 6th to complete the four year plans.

April 4th PTECH presentation to HHS Sophomore and Freshmen students: Molly Huckabee, a PTECH representative came to HHS on April 4th to meet with our 9th and some of our interested 10th graders to discuss the potential for students to participate in the PTECH program that will be starting up at Homedale HS in the fall of 2015. Students who were interested in participating in PTECH were given application to fill out. Academics and behavior were used to identify potential students to be selected to participate in the PTECH program. Seventeen students who applied were invited to attend a parent meeting to explain the expectations for the PTECH program on April 15th in the HS library. Out of those who attend, ten to fifteen students will be chosen to participate in the PTECH program this fall. These students will receive a lap top computer, will be provided an online advisor

and will receive online tutoring for their rigorous course loads. They will also have all of their tuition paid for until they receive their two year degree. HHS will add ten to fifteen new students into the PTECH program each year. This will be a great opportunity for many of our students at HHS.

April 8th-11th State FFA Convention in Twin Falls: Thirty HHS students attended the State FFA Convention in Twin Falls April 8th – 11th.

The Homedale FFA received the FFA Monsanto Grow Your Community Grant for \$2,500.00 – this grant will fund two scholarships to the Washington Leadership Conference this summer.
