We had our second attendance incentive on Friday, January 19, 2024. Students went bowling in Cut Bank. All the students, staff, and volunteers had a great time.



All students in Kindergarten and first grade have completed their Winter AimsWebPlus Assessments in both Math and Reading.




3-6 Classroom: Suzanne Augare







AimsWeb Reading 3-6
