- 1. Educational goals While the overall purpose of the trip is a cheerleader competition against teams across the world, we hope to expand the cheerleader's global understanding through a variety of Hawaiian landmarks.
 - a. Pearl Harbor tour No trip to Oahu would be complete without visiting Hawaii's most popular tourist attraction ... the **USS Arizona Memorial**. The tours feature such things as the Arizona Memorial visitor's center, documentary film, and the ferry boat ride which takes you out to the memorial. From there you will gaze down into the water where just below the surface lies the decks of USS Arizona, final resting place for many of the 1177 crew members who lost their lives on December 7, 1941.
 - b. Diamond Head Hawaii's most recognized natural landmark is known for its historic hiking trail, stunning coastal views, and military history. Diamond Head State Monument encompasses over 475 acres, including the interior and outer slopes of the crater.
 - c. Ocean excursion This could comprise of several different things. In the past we have gone snorkeling in a Hanauma Bay, catamaran trip, and whale watching.
