Summer School

While it seems pretty early at this point, summer school planning is underway! Frederic will again design an exciting, rich program. We are always looking to maximize opportunities for students, so we maximize participation. We aren't yet close to a finalized schedule, but it's in the works.

Inclement Weather Days

While we still have quite a bit of winter left, we are watching the inclement weather days closely. In order to reach the state's instructional hours requirement, we must reach the following minimum thresholds: 7-12: 1137 4K-6: 1050. We have had to use 4 inclement weather days so far. Given the number of days on our calendar, and the daily schedules of our buildings, we could absorb 7 total days to meet the minimum requirements. As in previous years, we are beginning to plan for potential staff time, somewhat trying to predict what the rest of winter will bring.

Reading and Writing Strategies in All Subjects

Each of our in-service days has had a portion devoted to reading and writing strategies that can be used with all teachers in their subject areas, which has been a common focus point throughout the year. The information is presented by our Reading Specialist, Ms. O'Connor, and then implemented/practiced by the teachers during the time between training days. The cycle of learning, implementation, and reflection is a key component to our Professional Learning Community practices and focus on strengthening our universal instruction.

These strategies have been woven into the ongoing work related to standards based learning. This includes the continuous learning and improvement process related to our newest curriculums.
