



Trends in our Implementation of No Red Ink is ABOVE TREND! This also leads to practicing of writing skills, grammar and spelling—this also leads to our improved writing scores.



While our My ACCESS Writing Assessment scores have made progress (19% growth from October to May), the average score for ACT is 6-7 on a scale from 2-12. Our ACT Mean score for writing is 5.3. So what we are doing in the area of writing is working! BHS has changed the process for My Access-all grades use the ACT writing process format for our writing assessment.


