## **Summary:**

In a 2011 special session, state lawmakers approved Senate Bill 6, which created a new Instructional Materials Allotment system for the purchase of all instructional materials, technological equipment and technology related services. Under the new system, the state allocates local school districts with a set amount of funding for the biennium.

School districts must certify they have sufficient instructional materials to cover the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS), but have the option of using funds on the State Board of Education adopted materials or non-adopted instructional materials, as well as technology.
