We would like to send a team of four or five teachers to the AP Workshops in Bellevue, WA on October 17. We would like to add AP World History, AP Government and Politics, and AP Chemistry to our curriculum and add to the expertise of our AP Literature teacher. The classes are on Saturday and it will require two days of travel.

Hidden Valley needs to be able to expand the number of AP classes. Prior opportunities to attend were not taken by our staff. We have a strong team of candidates who are willing to serve in this capacity. Teachers will access the TREA Professional development fund for their expenses.
