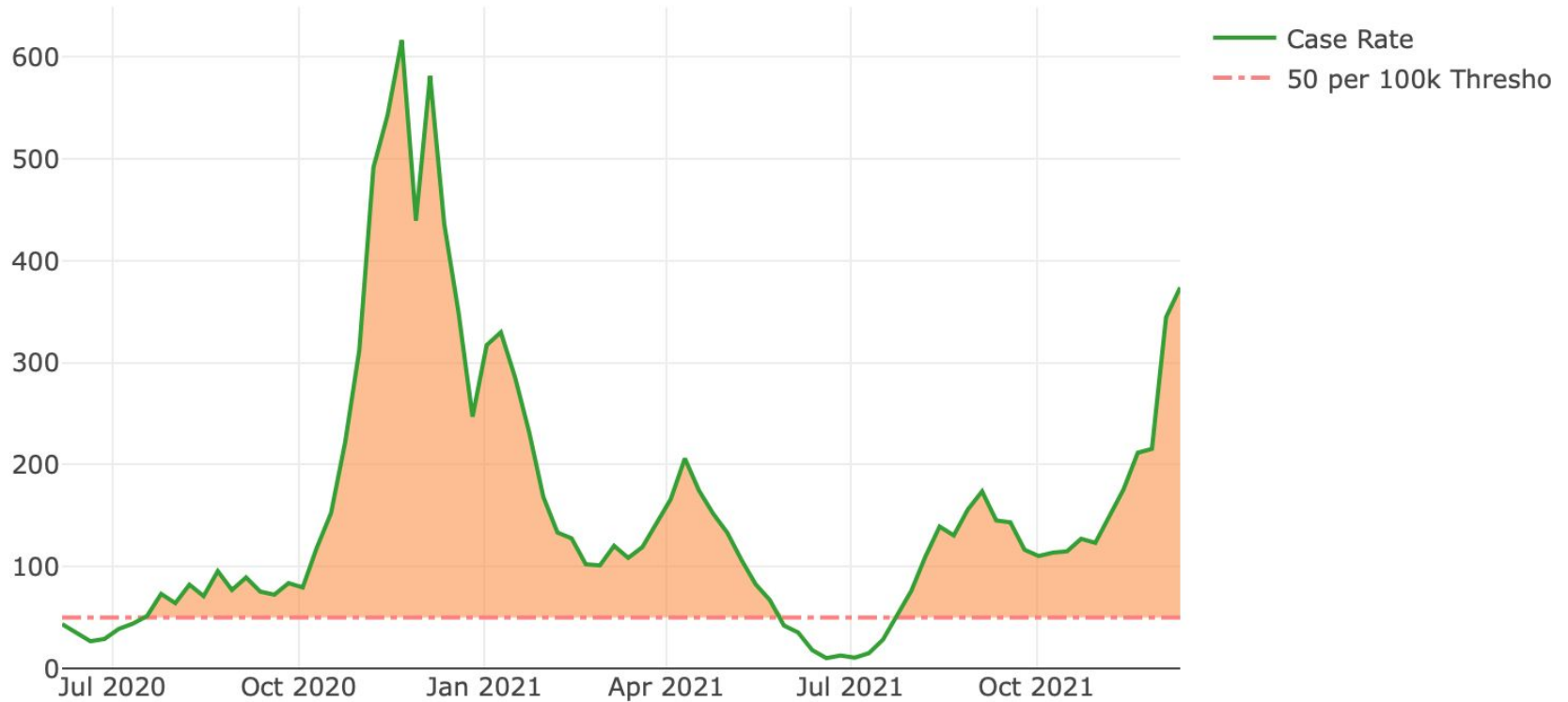

COVID-19 Testing in Our Schools

- Partner: Northshore Clinical Lab
- Services Offered in D12
 - Opt-in weekly screening for students and staff
 - On-demand test at request of parent (for student) or staff (for self) if symptomatic, upon return from travel, etc.
 - Test to stay when identified as a close contact at school
- Testing method: cheek swab
- Testing conducted by: Northshore Clinical for weekly screening, D12 health office staff for on-demand, test to stay
- Cost: None (Insurance will be billed but co-pays, deductible, etc. will not be applicable)



Overview of Process

- Parent signs permission for student to be tested
- Parent signs up with student/parent information on Northshore portal
- Student tested at school site (cheek swab)
- Results provided to school and parent within 24-48 hours
- Test to Stay
 - Student is identified as a close contact *at school*
 - Student may remain in school as long as they are symptom-free and participates in on-site testing on Days 1, 3, 5, and 7 after exposure
- Required testing for extracurricular participation: Not required at this time but the district reserves the right to adjust this decision if positive cases/quarantine numbers warrants



FAQ

Do fully vaccinated individuals need to test in order to remain in school if they are close contacts? No, fully vaccinated individuals do not need to quarantine or participate in test to stay in order to remain in school.

What is needed in order to register on Northshore's Parent Portal? The parent's driver's license or state issued ID and insurance information. If the student is uninsured, there will be information to check off but a driver's license or state issued ID will still be required.

May I get my child tested elsewhere for test to stay? No, a student identified as a close contact must use our school-based testing program so that we have timely access to all test results.

Why are we adding testing now? As our information evolves, so do our protocols. Adding testing as another layer of mitigation increases the opportunity for students to remain in school and for our schools to remain open.
