First Reading (Action Item)

NSBSD Policy Manual:

Board Bylaw 9311, Board Policies:... Prior to adoption, policies shall normally be given two readings by the Board. At its second reading, the policy may be adopted by a majority vote of all members of the Board.

NSBSD Strategic Plan Summary:

1.0 Prioritize and implement intentional and purposeful partnerships.

Issue Summary:

BP 3515.5, Restrictions on Sex Offenders on Campus (New) is a new policy recommended for adoption by the Association of Alaska School Boards that prohibits non-parent sex offenders from coming onto school grounds and that puts reasonable procedures in place for sex offenders that are parents of students enrolled in district schools.

Section 8000, <u>Community</u> School Advisory Council is a draft provided by the District's Attorney according to the direction of the Board at the Summer Retreat to clarify the SAC's role.
