SUGGESTED SCHOOL BOARD ACTION:

DESCRIPTION:

State law requires that school districts which enroll ten or more American Indian students establish an American Indian Parent Advisory Committee to afford parents the opportunity to express their views concerning the educational needs of the American Indian children enrolled in the school district.

Annually, the Advisory Committee must pass a resolution indicating satisfaction with the district's current programs in meeting the needs of the American Indian students, or make recommendations to the school board to improve educational opportunities for these students.

The BHM American Indian Parent Advisory Committee met on January 20, 2022 and has issued a vote of concurrence for 2022. The compliance documentation will be submitted to MDE by the March 1, 2022 deadline.
